



Within the European Union, Aapa mires are only found in the northern Boreal region and the adjacent part of the Alpine region. They are complexes of several types of mire such as string fens, flarks and unraised bog moss (*Sphagnum* species) dominated bogs. Assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' for the Boreal region with 'structure and function' and 'future prospects' considered poor in both Finland and Sweden, with area also considered poor in Finland. Threats and pressures are mostly related to inappropriate land use and management, including drainage. Assessed as 'favourable' for the Alpine region.
