



Estuaries are complex habitats found on all of Europe's coastline and usually contain several other annex I habitats such as mudflats and saltmarshes, there is much variation, partly linked to tidal range which can vary from very little in the Baltic to very large as in parts of the Atlantic region where it can exceed 10m.

Very few countries have assessed this habitat as 'favourable' and it has been assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' in all regions except the Mediterranean (where the data does not allow an assessment but where it is probably also unfavourable). These assessments are mostly due to the 'structure and function' of the habitat although future prospects are also partly responsible.

Threats and pressures are numerous, many linked to development, use and water quality
