



Intertidal mudflats and sandflats are most widespread in the Atlantic region although also found elsewhere. The Baltic form of the habitat only reported from Estonia and Sweden also occurs elsewhere in regions of little tidal amplitude such as the Black Sea. Assessed as unfavourable everywhere except Macaronesia where it is 'unknown', with 'unfavourable-bad' in the Atlantic, Continental & Mediterranean regions and unfavourable-inadequate in the Boreal. These assessments are due to the reported 'structure and function' and Future prospects.

Better information is required from the Macaronesian and Mediterranean regions.
