


This habitat is found in all coastal regions although there are some differences in interpretation between different countries. This may explain the absence of sites in Northern France compared to southern England.

'Unfavourable-bad' in all regions except for the Boreal where it is 'unfavourableinadequate'.

Pressures and threats are mostly linked to human activities.

Several parameters have been reported as unknown, particularly in the Mediterranean, and better information is required.
