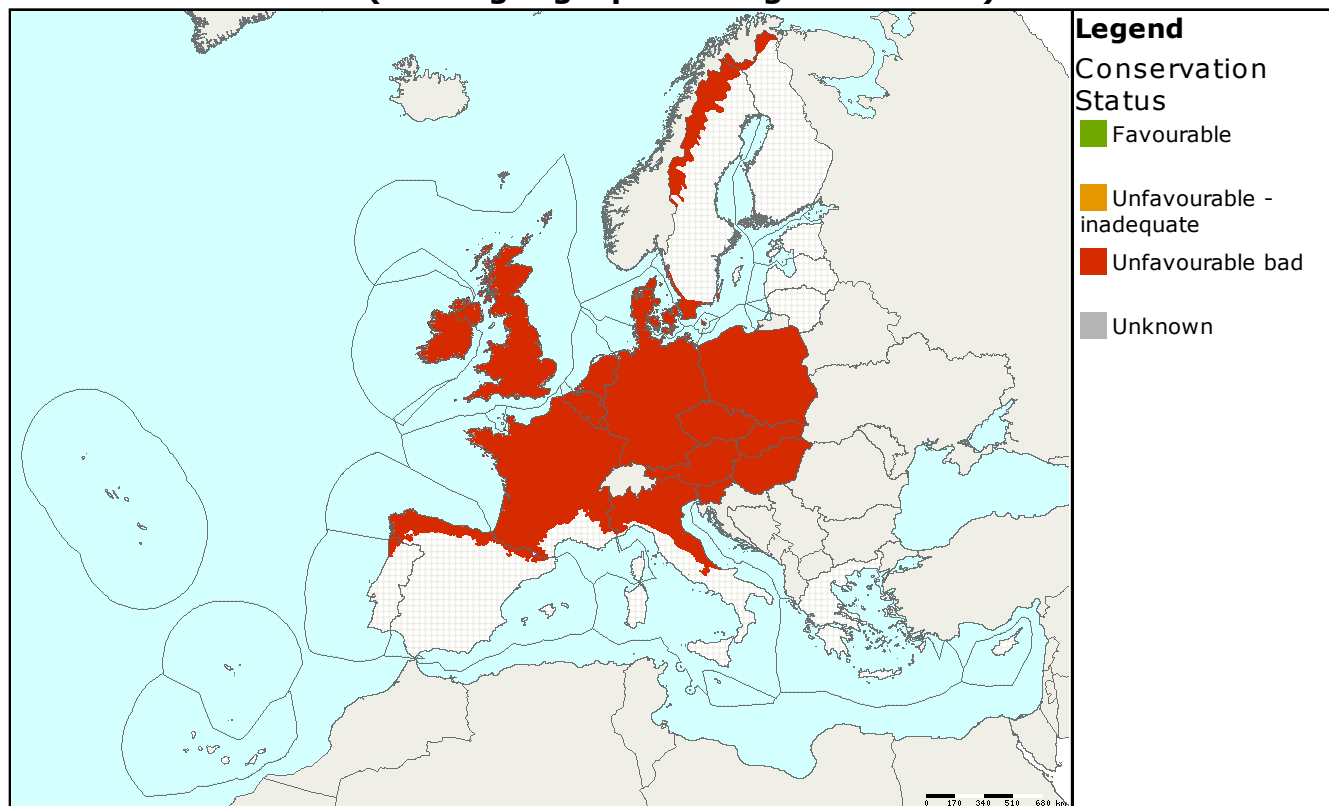

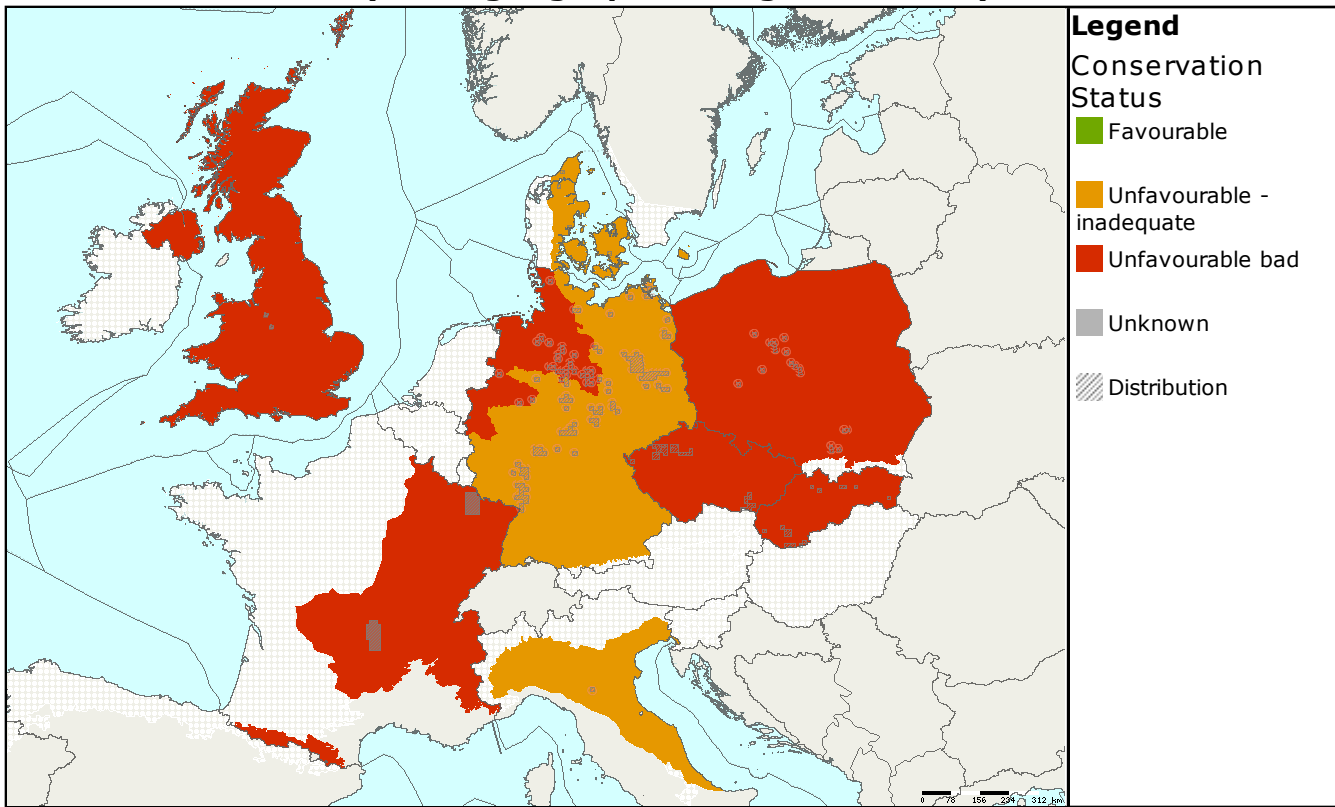

This habitat occurs where the groundwater is saline and the vegetation is formed by salt tolerant plants. This habitat is quite rare in Europe, and mostly found in the Continental region although there are a few sites in the Alpine, Atlantic and Pannonic regions. Elsewhere in Europe there are other habitats on saline soils such as 1510 or 1530. The habitat has been assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' in all regions and by most countries. In many countries the area of this habitat has declined, while 'structure & function' and 'future prospects' are unfavourable everywhere except Germany, or unknown.
