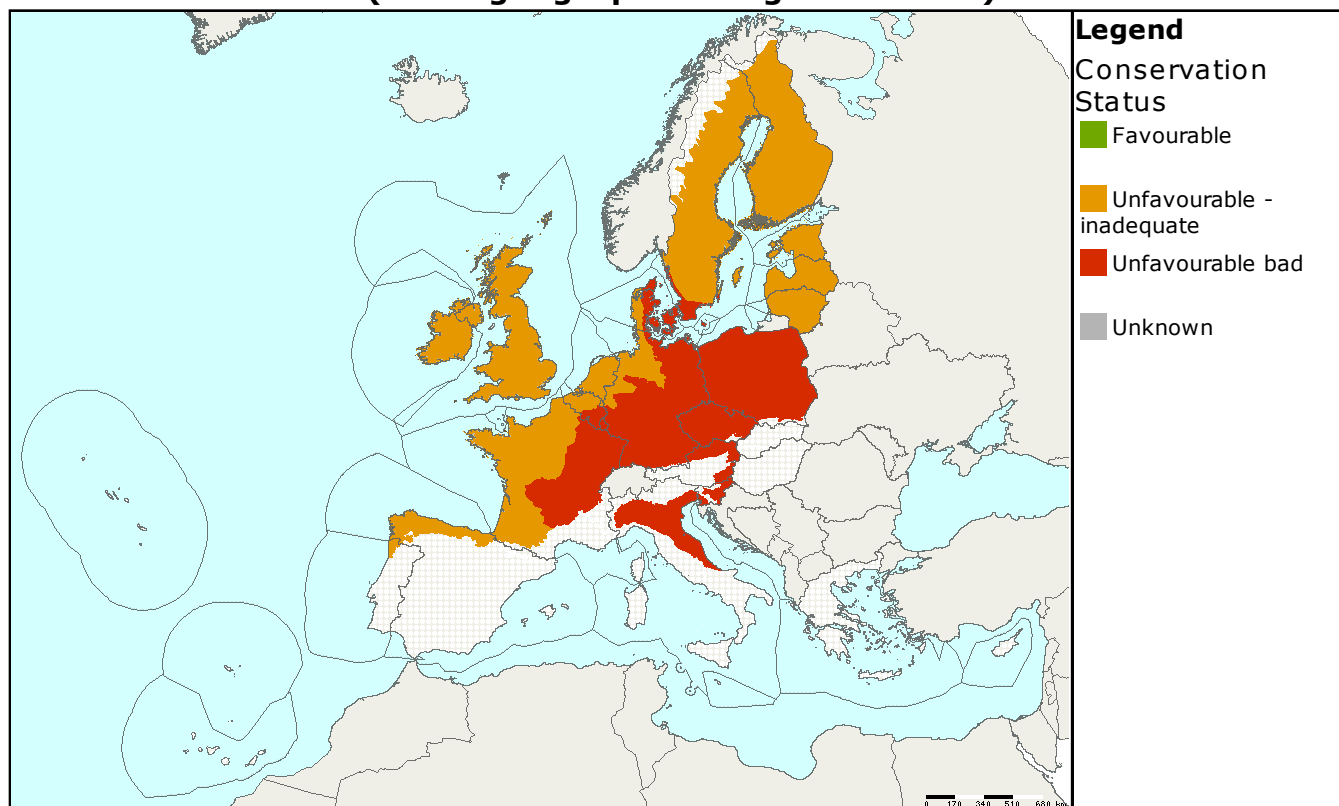

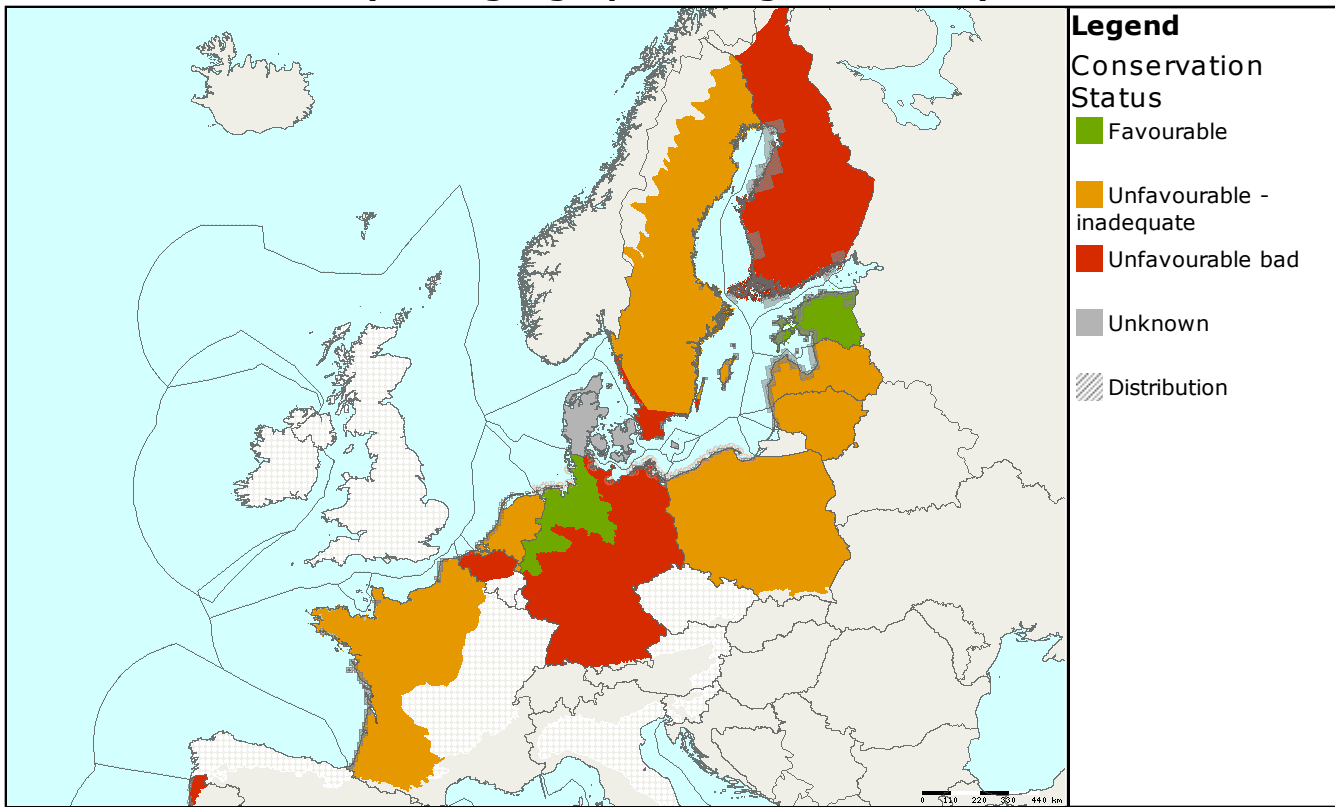
Dunes with natural woodland (both broadleaved and conifer) occur along the coasts of the Atlantic and Baltic in the Atlantic, Boreal and Continental regions. Wooded dunes in southern Europe are habitat type 2270.

Assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' in the Atlantic and Boreal regions due to 'structure and function' and 'future prospects' but 'unfavourable-bad' in the Continental region due to Structure & function, particularly in Germany which has almost 30% of the habitat area within the region.

Pressures and threats include inappropriate forestry management, tourism and invasive species.
