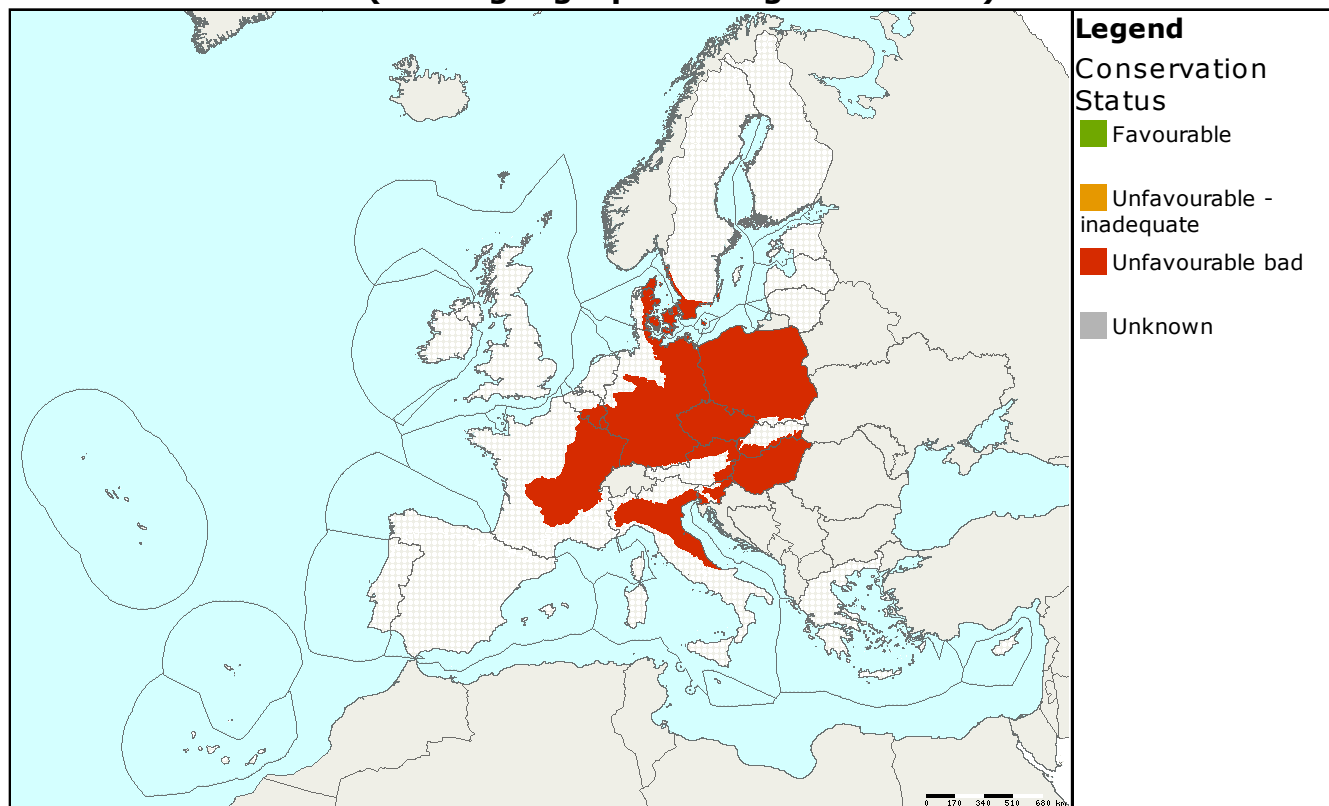

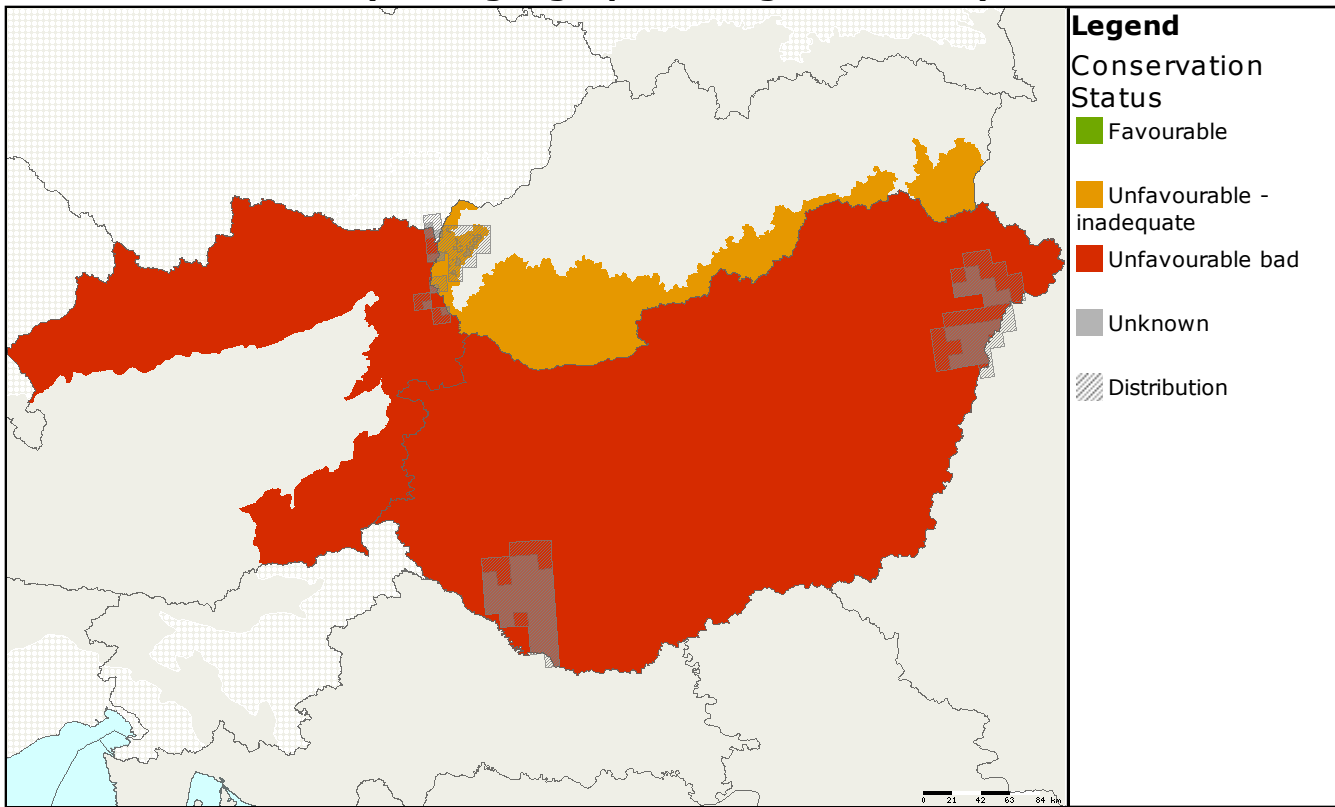

Dunes on the Pannonic plain and adjacent areas, often a mosaic of vegetation types including open, lichen rich dunes and a variety of grasslands. Similar vegetation not on dunes is included in habitat type 6260.

Assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' in both the Continental region (Austria) due to the area of habitat being much less than the favourable reference value. Also assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' for the Pannonian region where Hungary has reported all parameters as 'unfavourable-bad' and notes abandonment of traditional management, invasion by inappropriate species and seral development as important. In neighbouring Slovakia all parameters except 'structure and function' are reported as 'favourable'
