



Mixed oak-hornbeam (*Quercus* spp-*Carpinus betulus*) forests of central Europe occurring mostly in the areas with a sub-continental climate on various types of soil.

The conservation status in the Atlantic region, where the habitat occurs only in Germany and in the Pannonian region, where the species occurs only in the Czech republic is 'unfavourable bad'. The status in the Atlantic and Continental regions is 'unfavourable inadequate'.
