



This habitat includes a varied group of forests dominated by Pyrenean oak (*Quercus pyrenaica*) from the Iberian Penninsula and southwestern France with five regional subtypes described in the Interpretation Manual of European Union habitats.

The conservation status in both the Atlantic and Mediterranean regions is 'unknown' due to very incomplete information from Spain. However, for the Atlantic regions where a high proportion of the habitat is reported as 'unfavourable-inadequate', it is possible to conclude that the status is not favourable. Better information is required from Spain.
