



Rare and localised alder (Alnus glutinosa) woods of deep, steep-sided valleys in the warmer parts of the Iberian Peninsula with rare and endemic species including the shrub Rhododendron ponticum ssp baeticum. The humidity allows the development of a fern rich community which can include the Annex II and IV tree fern Culcita macrocarpa.

The conservation status is 'unknown' due to the very incomplete information received from Spain. However the conservation status is 'favourable' in Portugal and no major threats were reported.

Better information is required, particularly from Spain.
