

Dry grasslands of the Balkan peninsula, from northeastern Italy to Greece, similar to the grasslands of habitat type 6210 but with a greater number of plants typical of the Mediterranean basin including Annex II and IV plant species such as *Genista holopetala* and *Euphrasia marchesettii*. This habitat was added to Annex I in 2004. Within the EU25 this habitat occurs in the Alpine and Continental regions of Italy and Slovenia and in Greece (Mediterranean).

Assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' for both the Alpine and Continental regions as Slovenia, which has the majority of the habitat area in both regions, reported all parameters except 'range' as 'unfavourable-bad'. Threats and pressures are related to abandonment of traditional agriculture. Italy has assessed this habitat as 'favourable' in both regions.

Assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' for the Mediterranean (only Greece) where all parameters except 'structure and function' are 'poor'. Again the threats and pressures

are related to abandonment of traditional agriculture.
