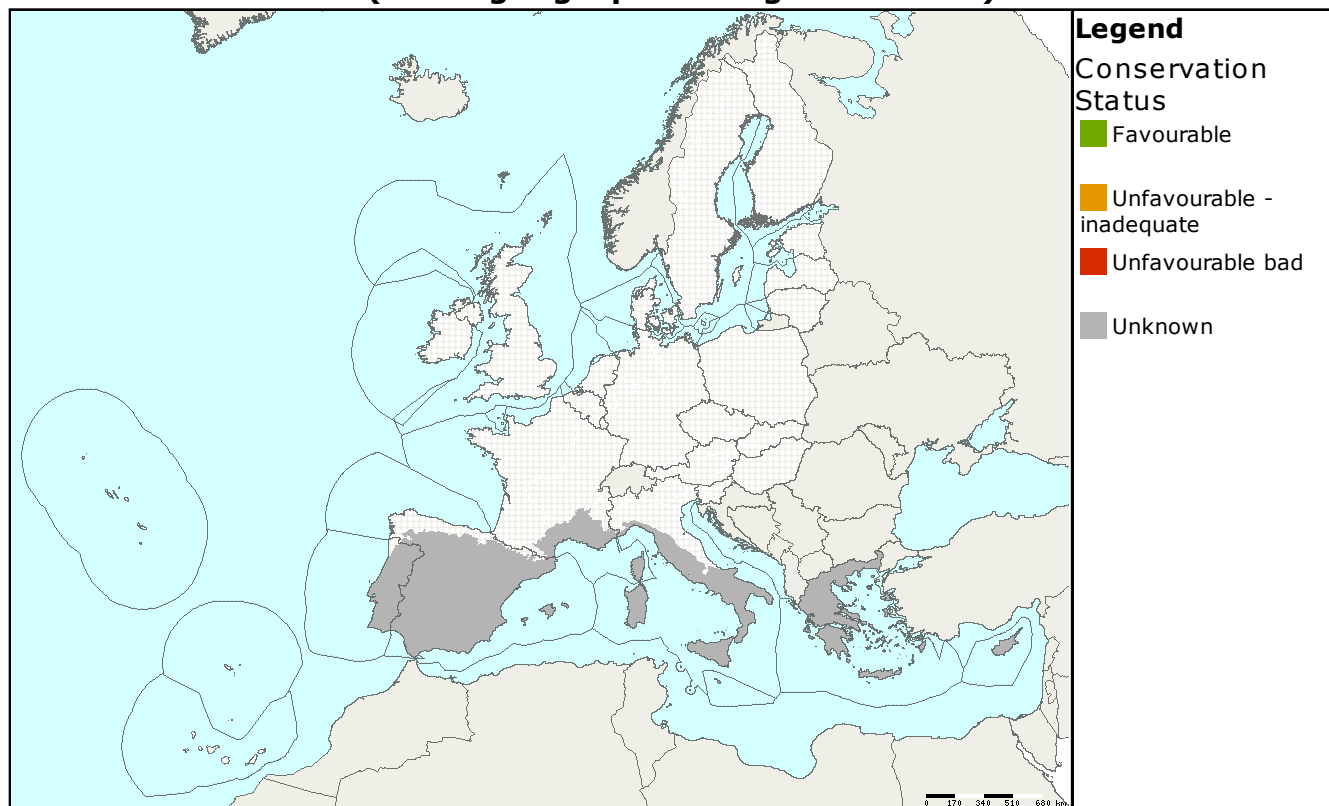

Dehesas are a typical landscape of the Iberian Peninsula with evergreen oaks such as cork oak (*Quercus suber*) growing over crops, pasture or matorral. Although typical of Spain and Portugal (where this habitat is known as montado), the habitat is also found locally in France and Italy.

Assessed as 'unknown but not favourable' as both France and Spain reported all parameters as 'unknown' and Italy and Portugal reported one parameter as unknown. Considered 'favourable' in Italy and 'unfavourable-inadequate' in Portugal. Better information required, especially from France and Spain.
