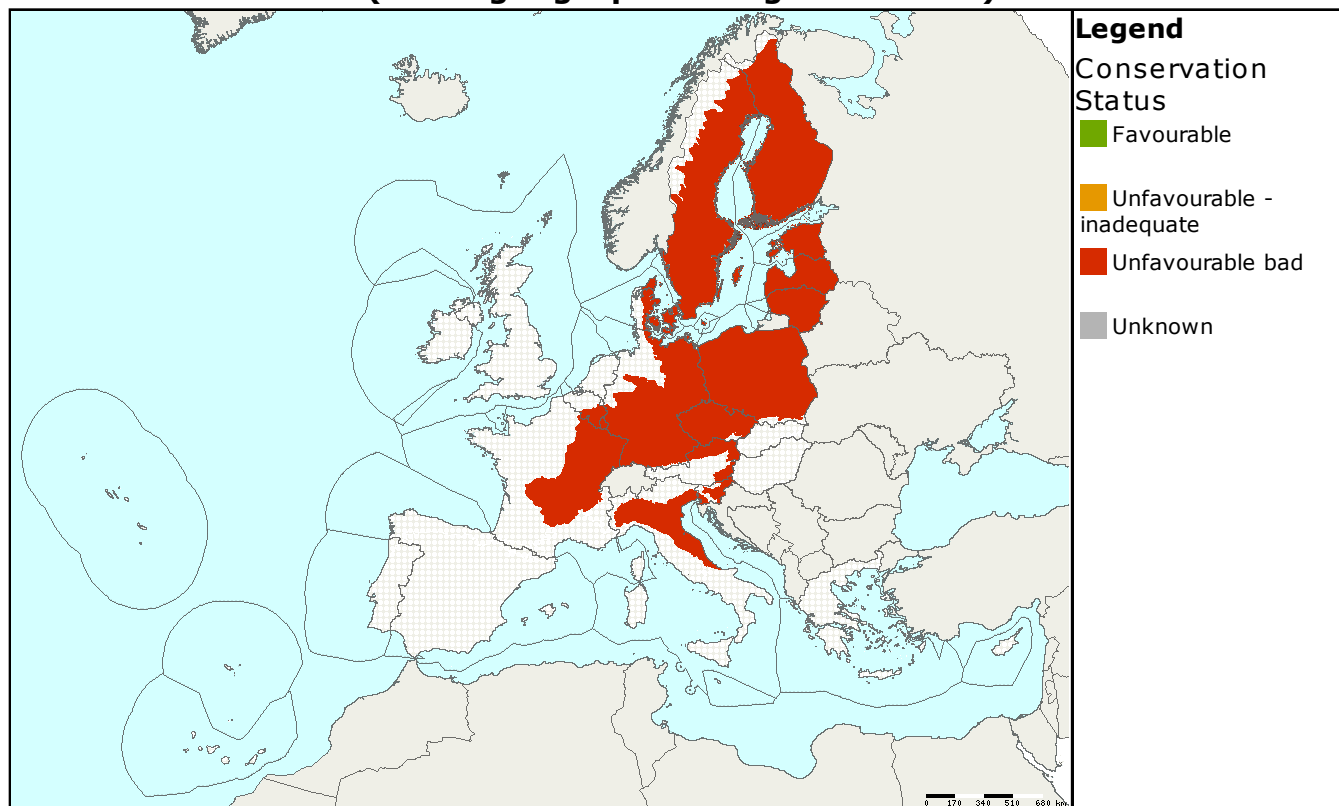

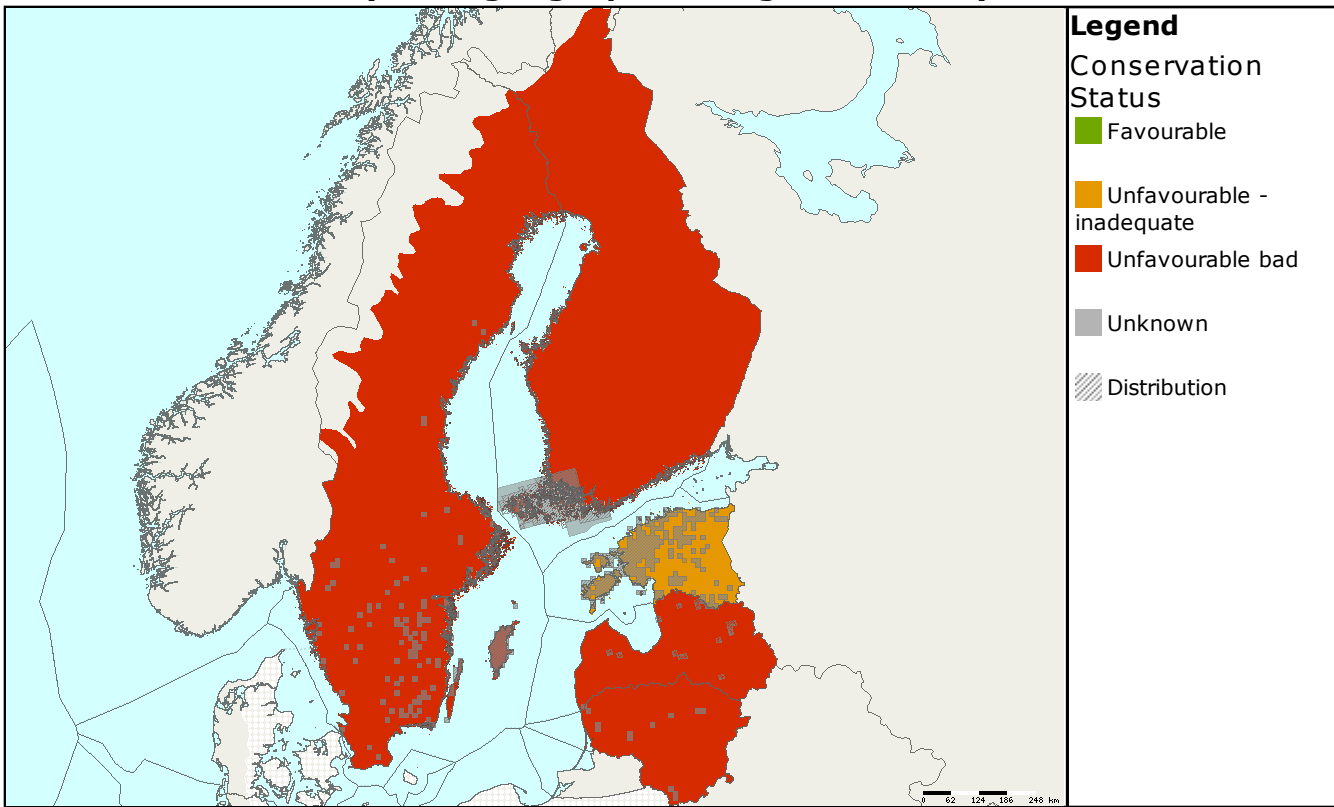

Traditionally these meadows with small copses of deciduous trees and scrub were managed with a mix of mowing and grazing, with pollarding of the trees. The meadows are species-rich while the trees support rich epiphyte communities of lichens and mosses. The habitat is restricted to the Boreal region together with the adjacent Continental region in southern Sweden. Assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' in both regions with Sweden reporting 'unfavourable-bad and deteriorating' for both regions. Threats and pressures are related to absence of appropriate management.
