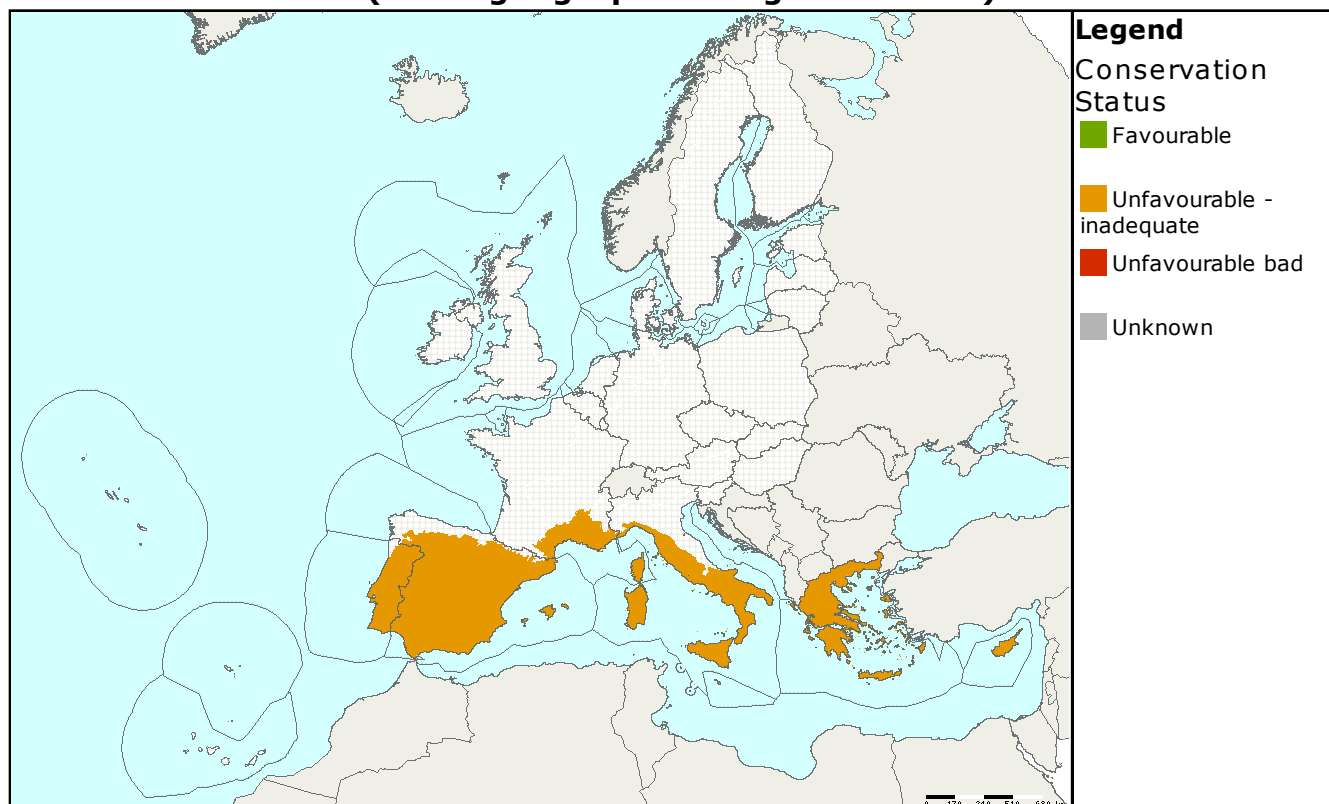

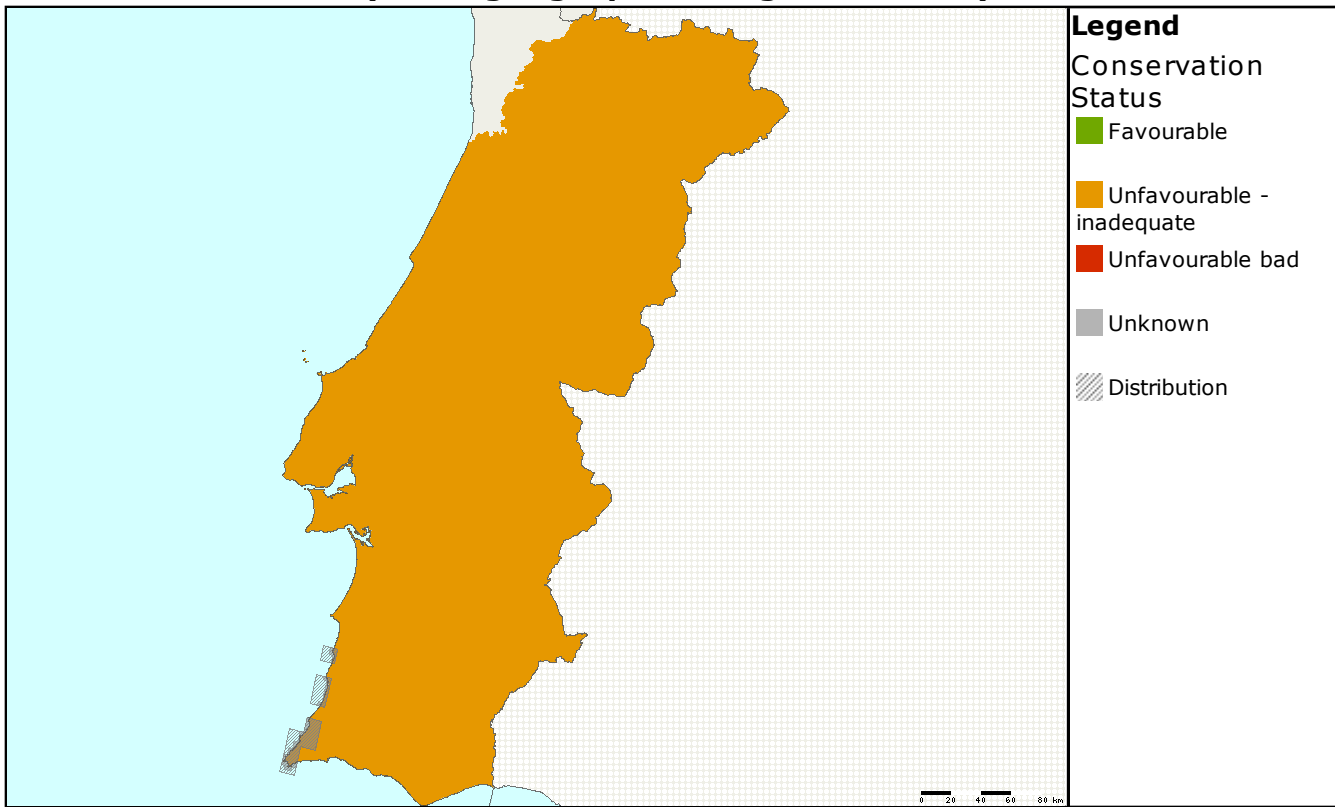

Coastal scrub with St. Vincent rockrose (*Cistus palhinhae*) growing on wet soils near the coast only occur in south-west Portugal. The vegetation is rich in endemic plant species. The habitat has been assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' both overall and for all parameters except range which is 'unknown'. The reported threats and pressures are mostly related to inappropriate land use and urbanisation.
