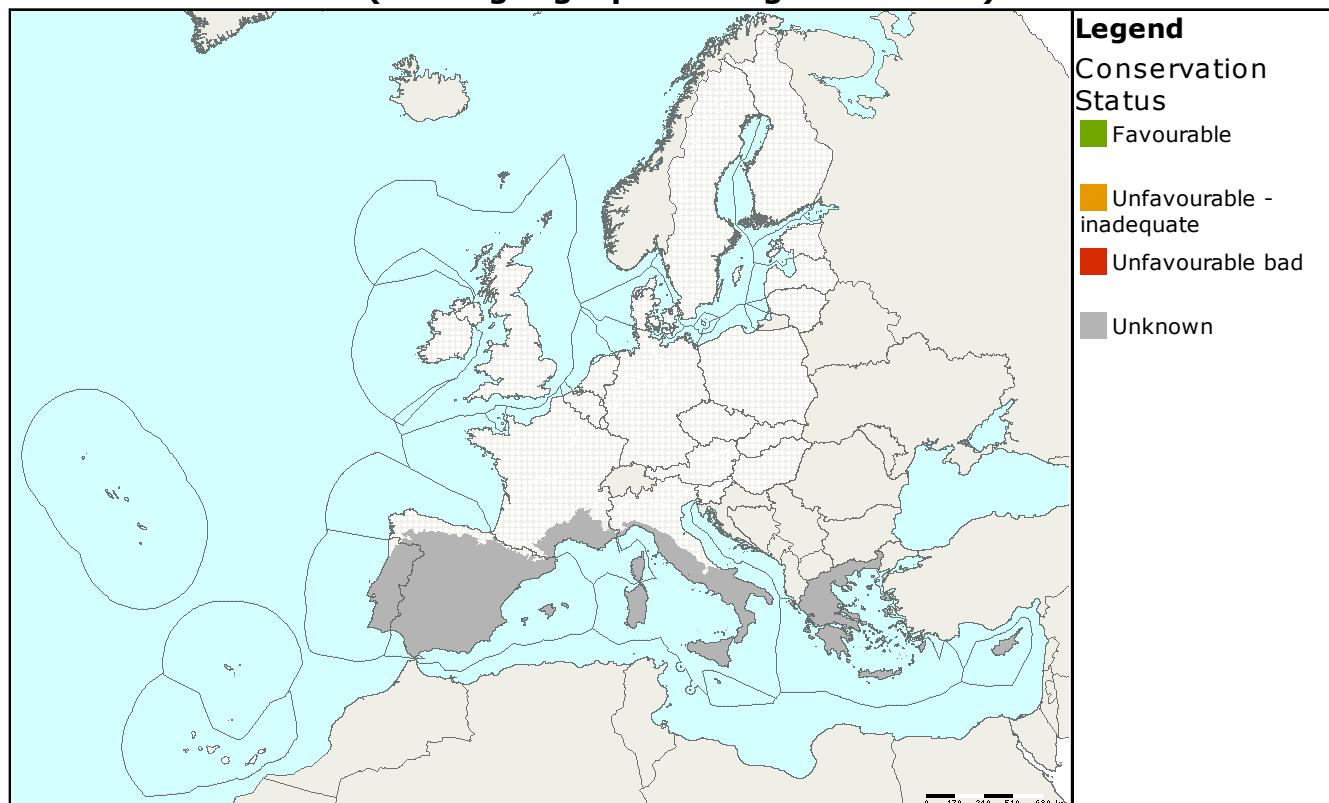

The valid name is *Pseudopus apodus*. The European glass lizard ranges from the Balkan Peninsula to southern Central Asia. Within the EU it is also present in Bulgaria. It inhabits dry rocky hill-sides covered with grasslands, maquis or open woods. It can also be found on cultivated land.

The conservation status is 'unknown'.
