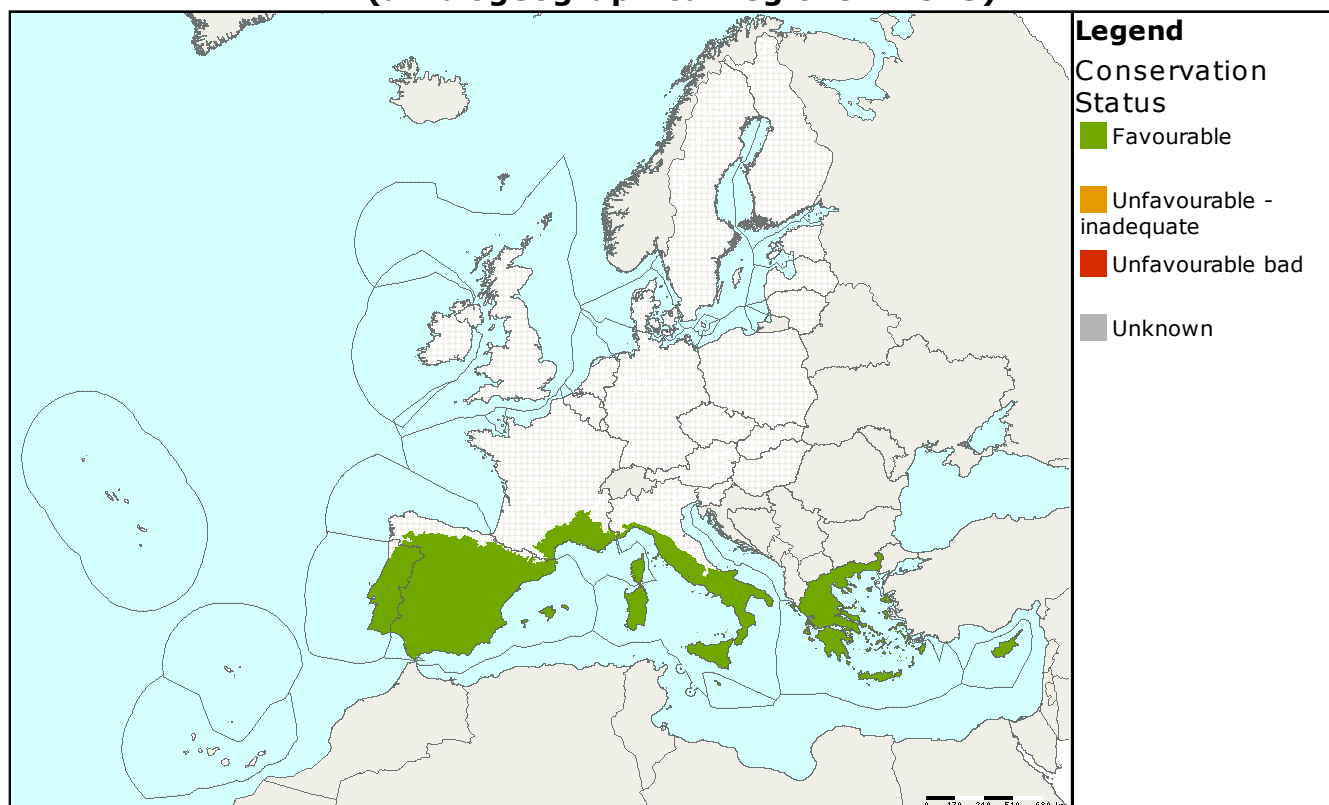

The Milos Wall Lizard endemic to the Aegean islands of Greece. It inhabits variety of habitats like maquis and phryganic vegetation, riparian shrub vegetation, rocky hills with scarce vegetation or even cultivated land.

The species occurs only in the Mediterranean biogeographical region. The conservations status is 'favourable', range and population size are stable and no major threats were recorded. However the species is included in the 2008 IUCN Red List in the category 'near threatened', mainly due to its restricted distribution.
