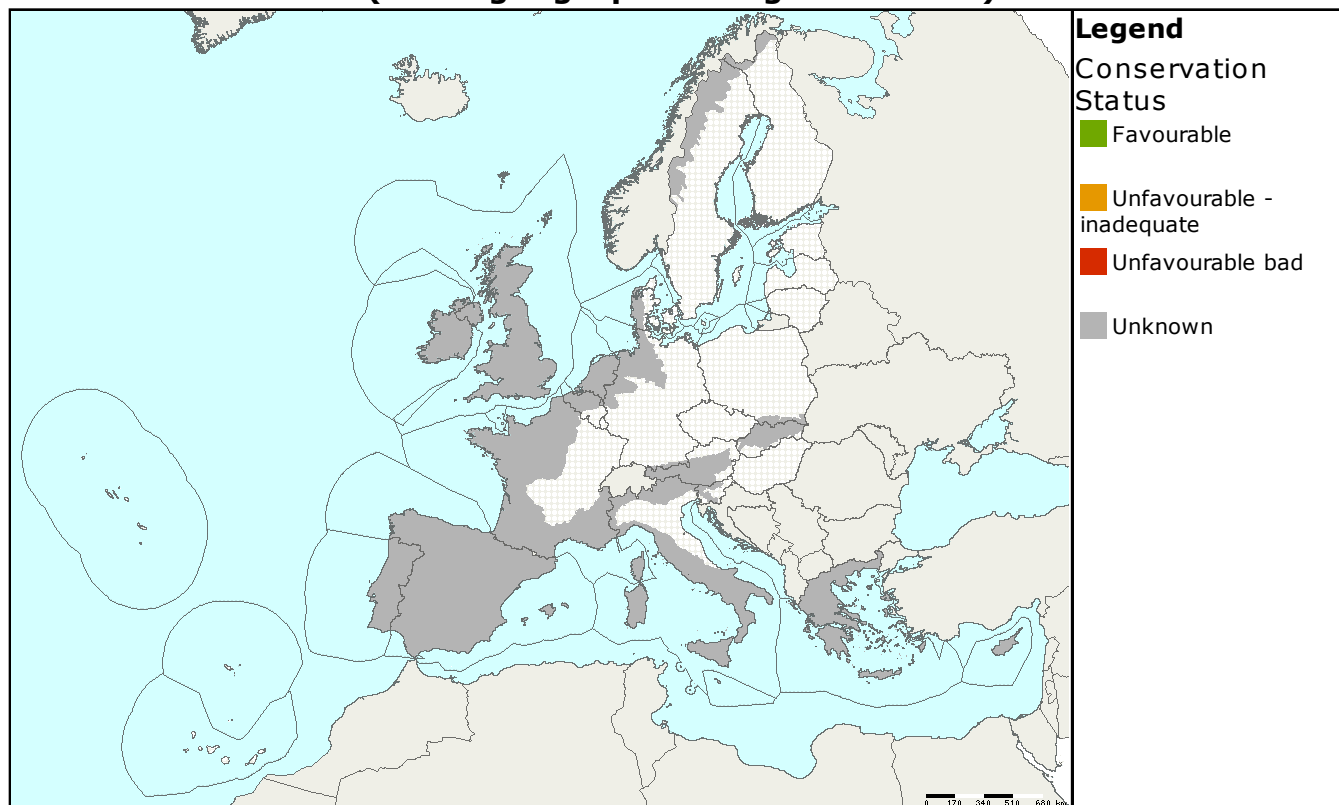

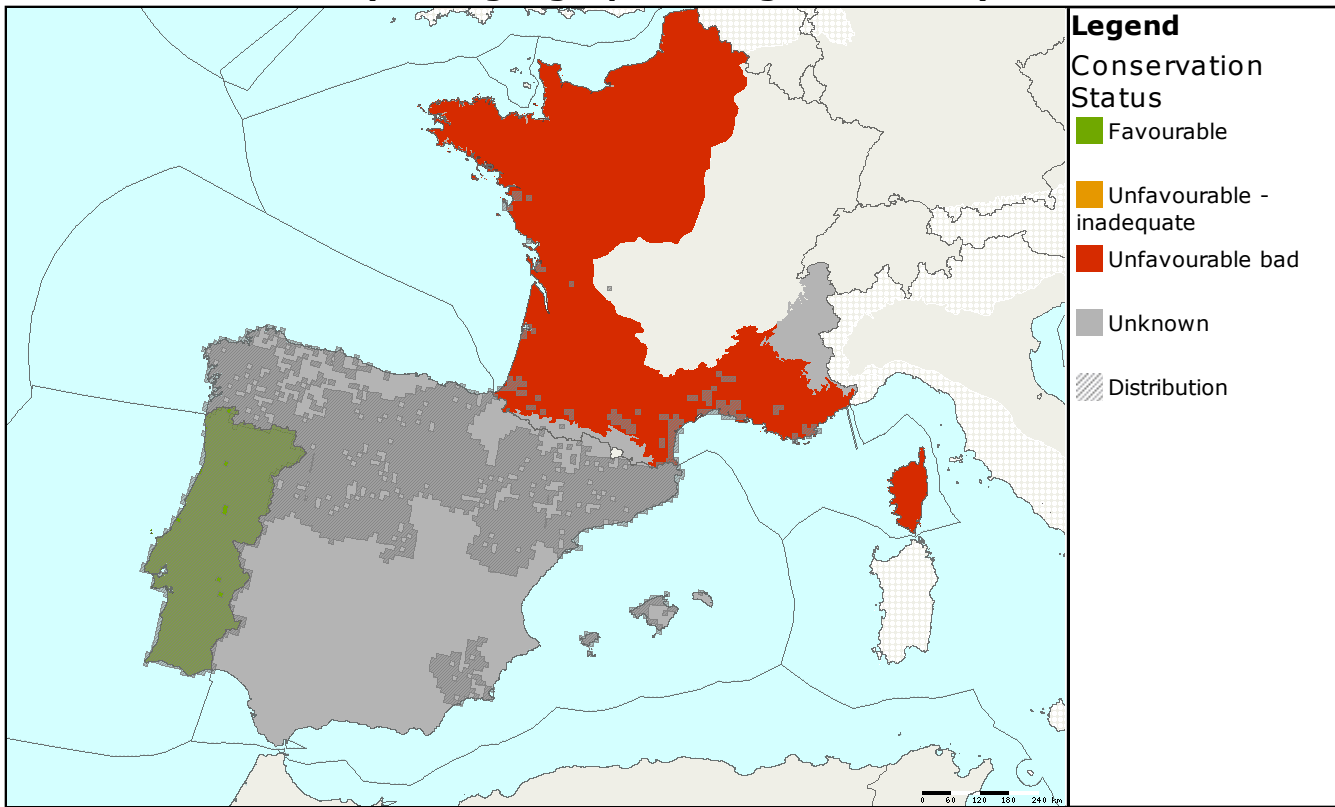

The Perez's frog occurs in France, Spain and Portugal. It inhabits a wide variety of temporary and permanent water bodies. The terrestrial habitats of the species include forests, Mediterranean-type scrub, agricultural areas, rocky areas, coastal marshes etc. The overall assessment for all three regions (Alpine, Atlantic and Mediterranean) are 'unknown'. However, French reports for Atlantic and Mediterranean regions are 'unfavourable-bad', while Portuguese are 'favourable'. According to IUCN species is still considered as 'least concern'.
