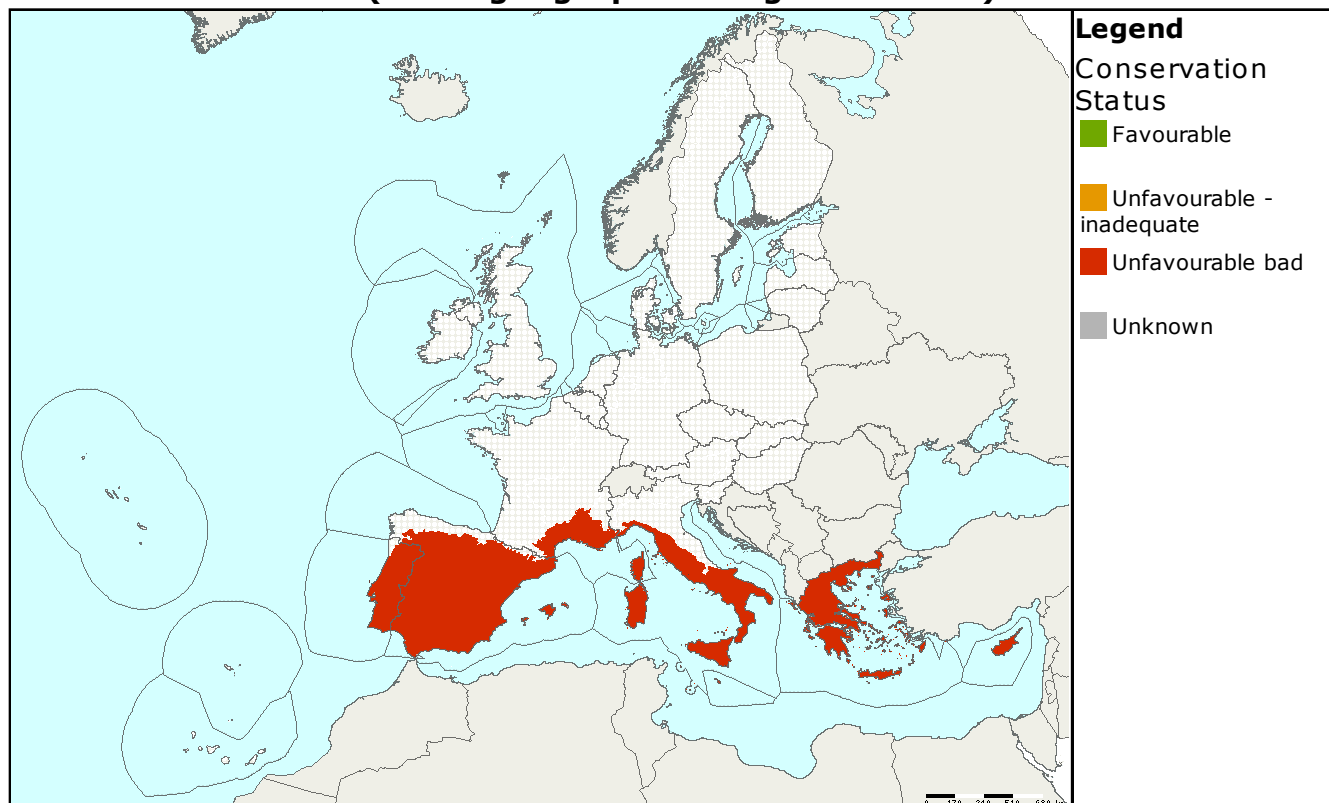

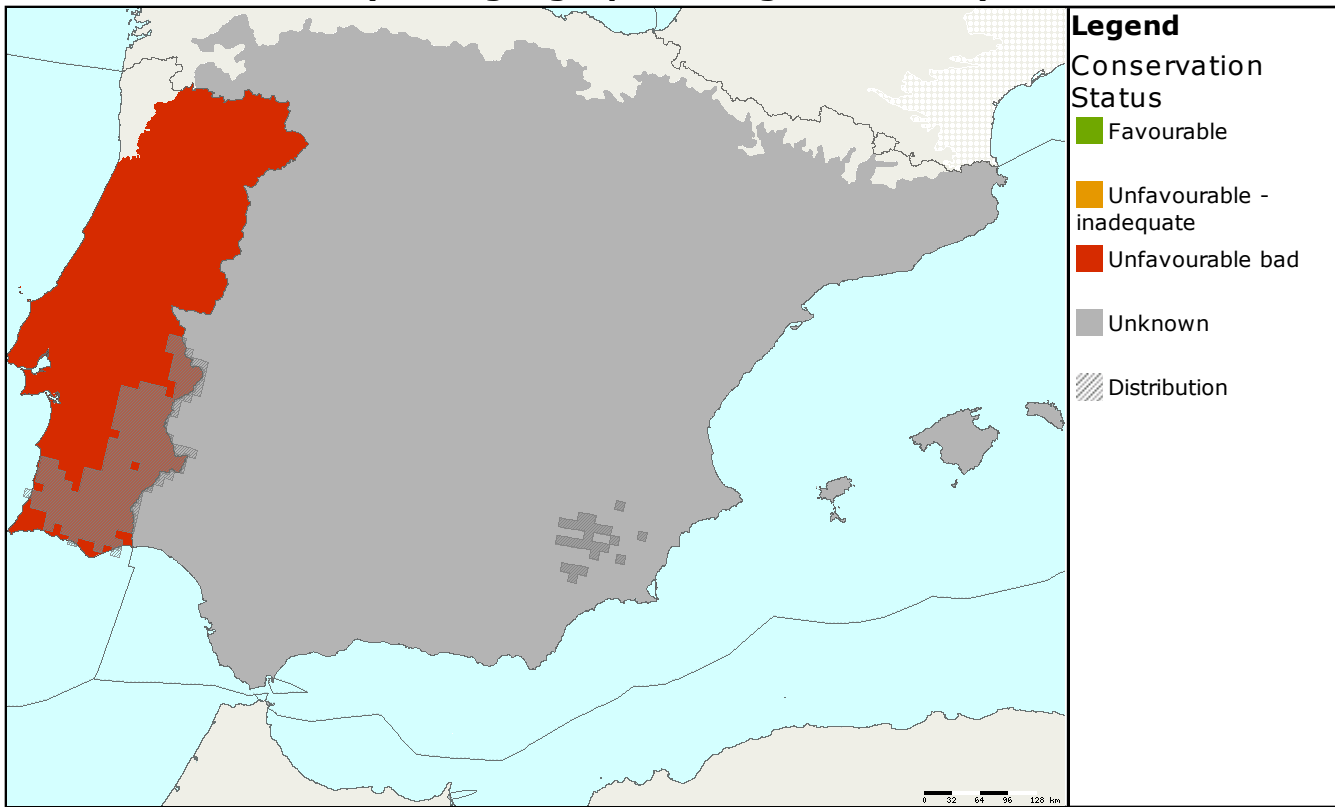

Barbus sclateri is a freshwater fish species native to southern Spain and Portugal (Mediterranean biogeographical region). Overall assessment is 'unfavourable-bad' because its status for population in Portugal is reported as such. In Portugal the majority (over 87%) of whole distribution area is located. According to IUCN the species have 'least concern' status.
