



ALP: Currently, there are several species/subspecies under the (taxonomically non-valid) name Salmo macrostigma: - Salmo cetti, Rafinesque, 1810, from Corsica, Sardinia,, Sicily and Southern Italy: conservation status evaluated by Italy for the Apennines is 'unfavourable-bad' - Salmo trutta macrostigma (Dumèril, 1858), endemic from Corsica Given the taxonomic uncertainties, no assessment of conservation status is made for the taxon named 'Salmo macrostigma'. MED: According to Fishbase name Salmo macrostigma is a non valid synonym for Salmo trutta macrostigma (Dumèril, 1858), endemic to Corsica. The Italian report refers to another taxa
