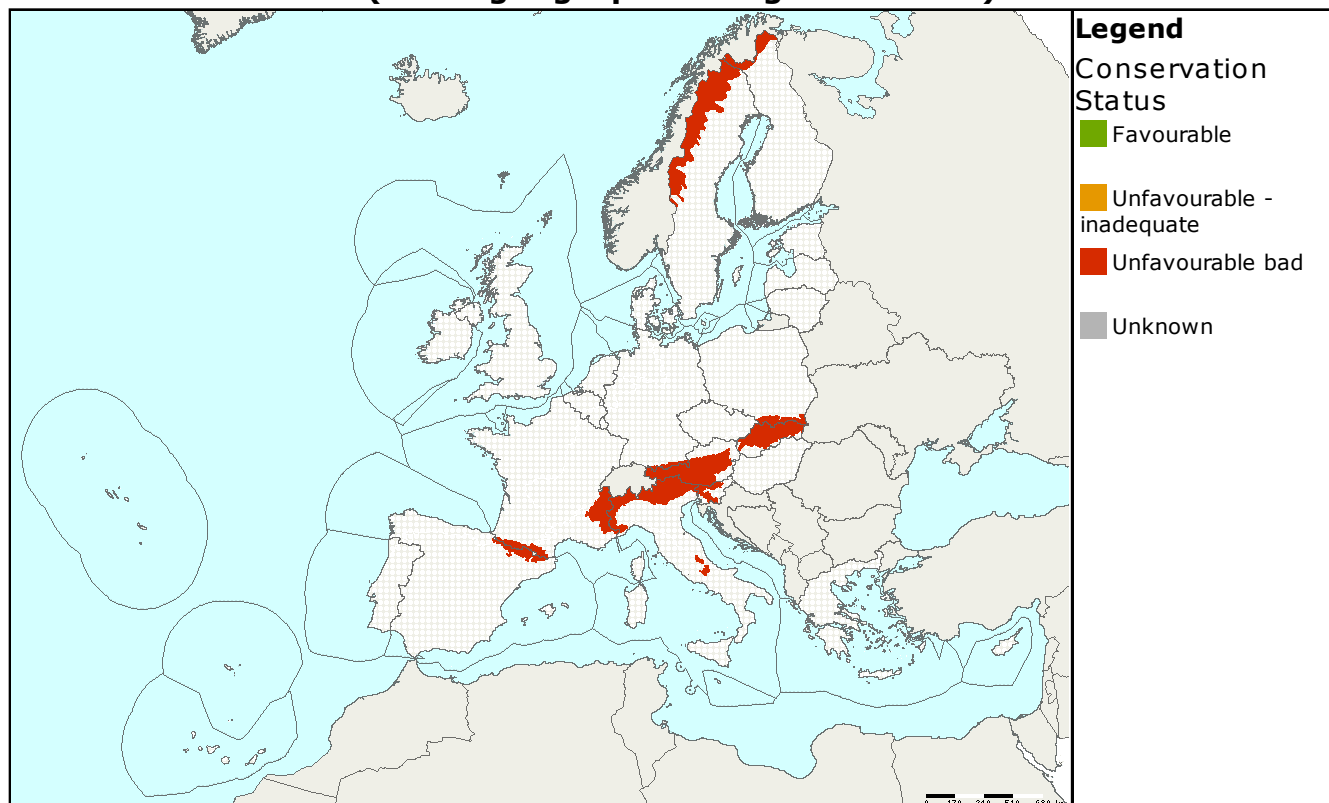

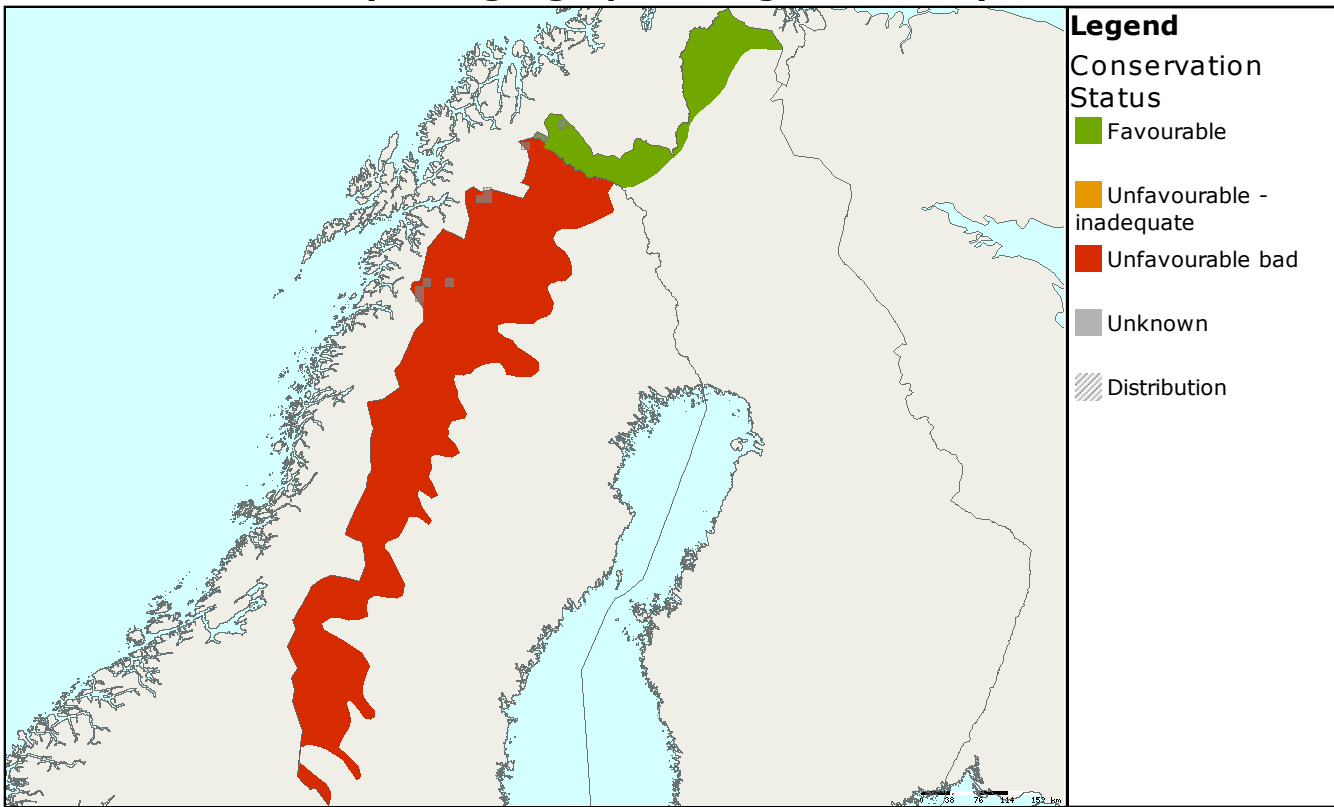

*Agríades glandon aquilo* is a butterfly species distributed in Scandinavia (Alpine region). It lives in inland sparsely vegetated habitats (short grass turf associated with slate or shale rocks, - consolidated areas of steep screes where vegetation can establish itself, etc). In Swedish alpine region the species is very local, but not uncommon. Suitable habitats for the species are not calculated due to lack of information. Overall assessment of this species is 'unfavourable-bad' because of its assessment in Sweden, where majority of its records occurs. Finnish report is 'favourable' in all parameters.
