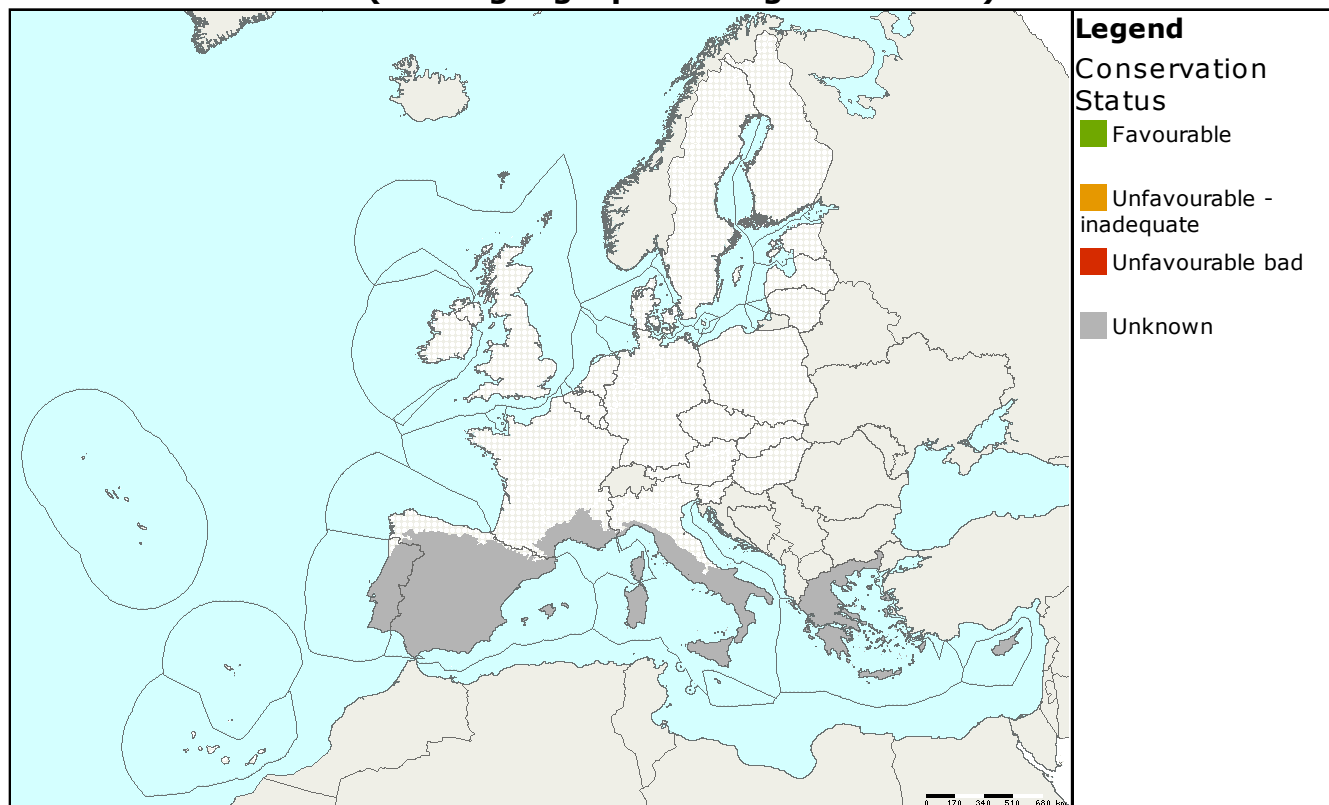

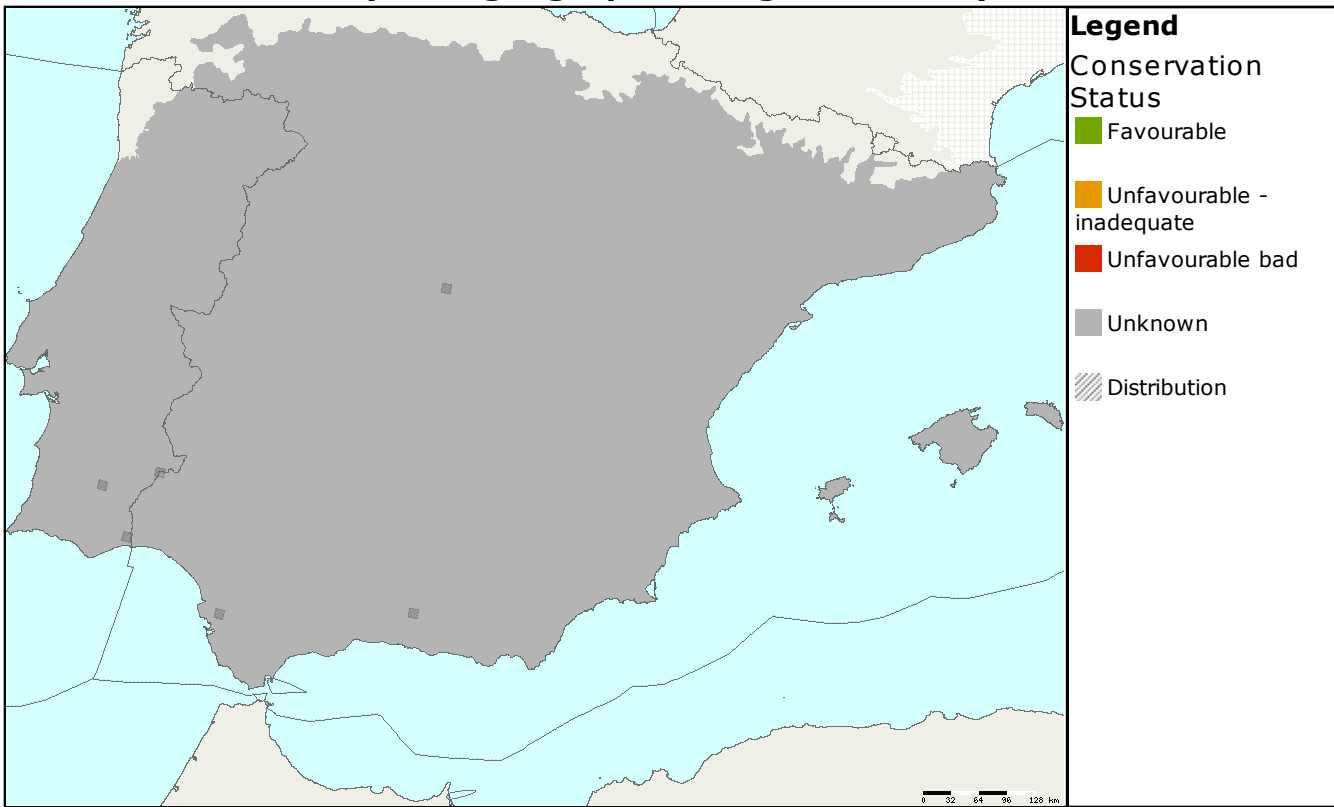

Apteromantis aptera is a praying mantis endemic to the Iberian Peninsula. Little information reported by Spain or Portugal, with no assessments from Portugal. Overall assessment is 'unknown'. Better information required. It is listed as 'near threatened' on UUCN Red List and as 'vulnerable' in Spanish Red Data Book.
