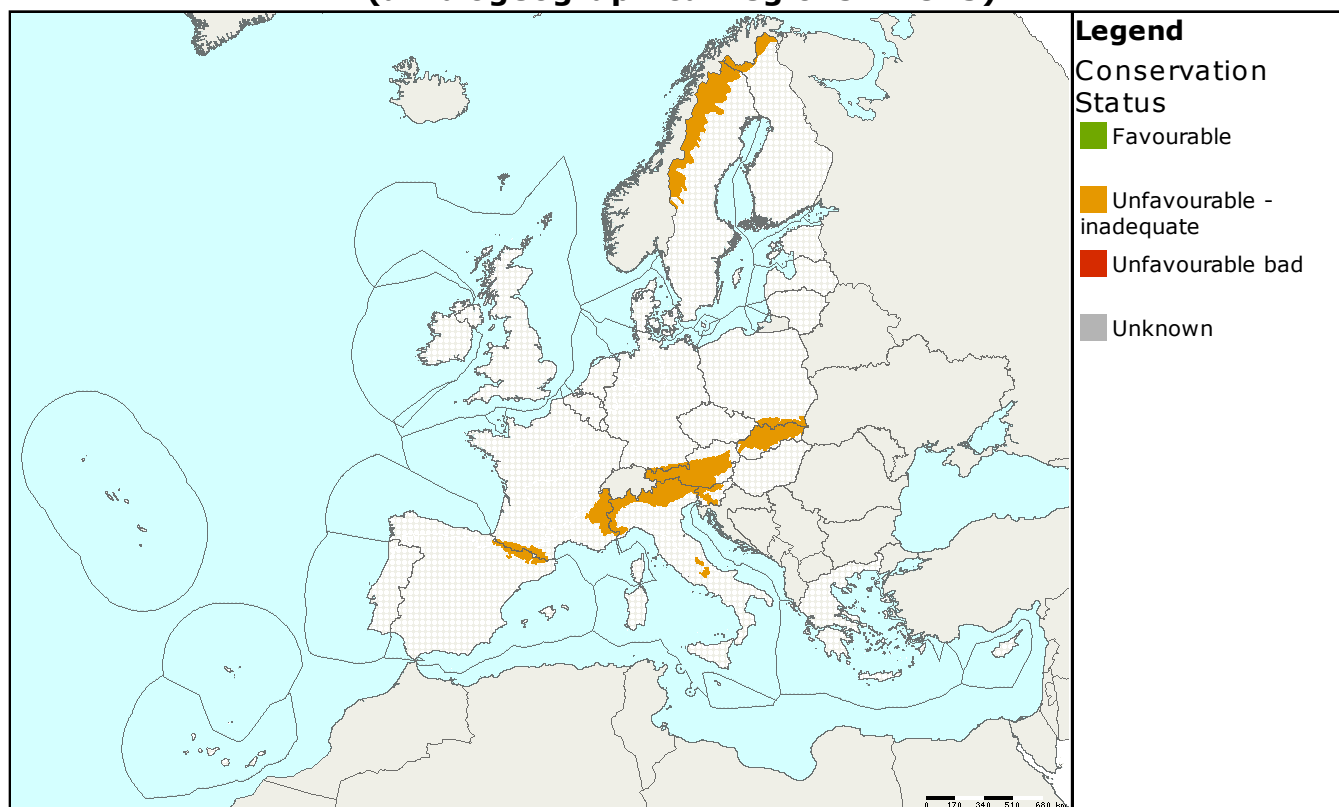

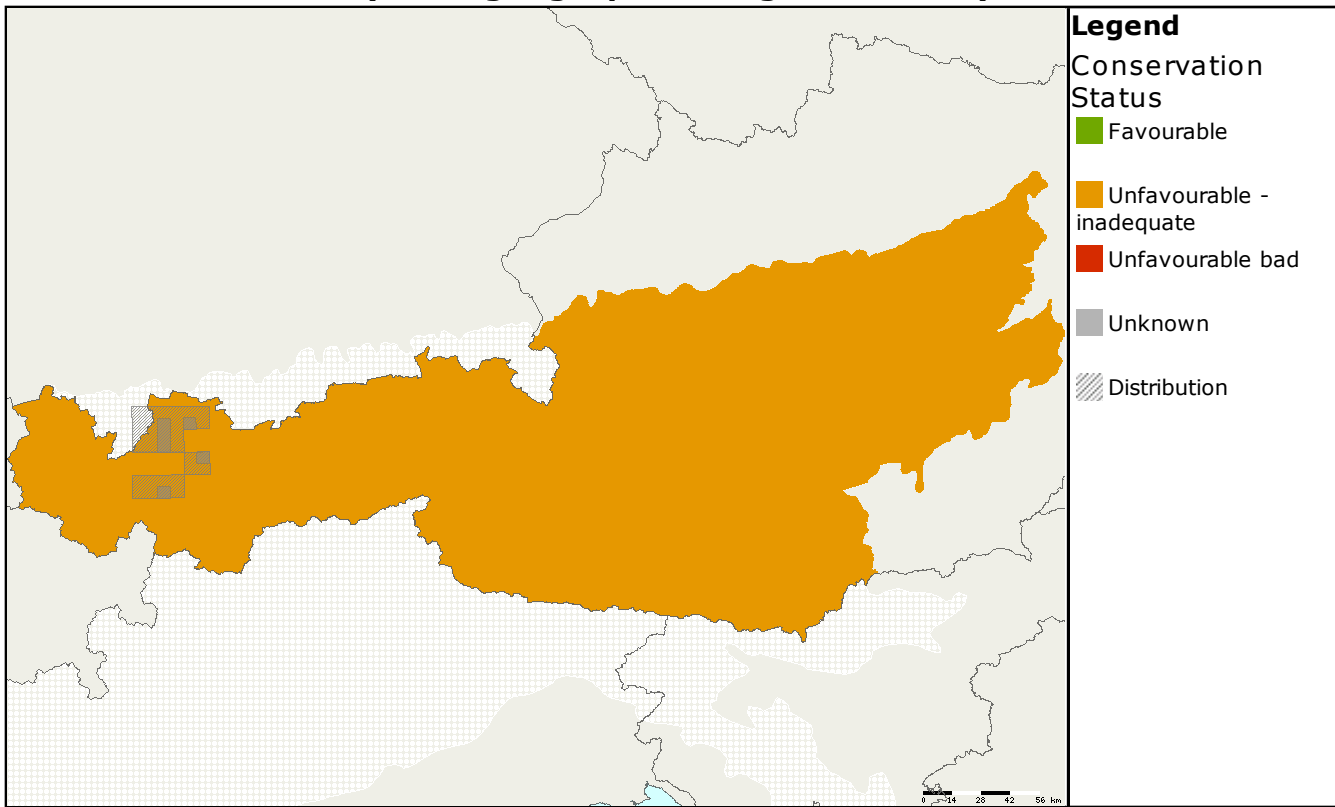

ALP: *Coenagrion hylas* is a north Asiatic species, occurring in the tundra. From MS, only one has an isolated population in the northern Alps. Due to habitat destruction and perhaps over-collecting the German population destroyed. From western Austria there are approximately 10 localities known. The overall assessment of this species is true.
