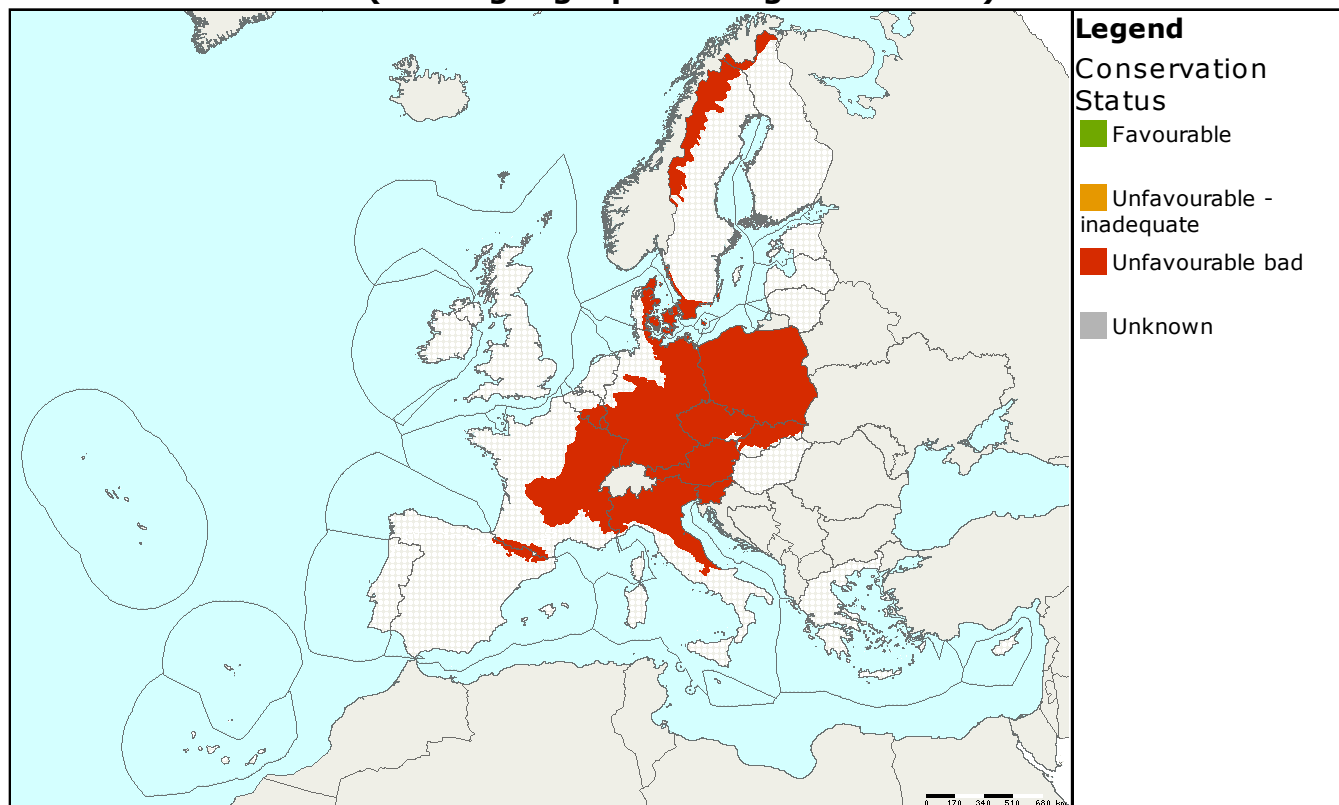

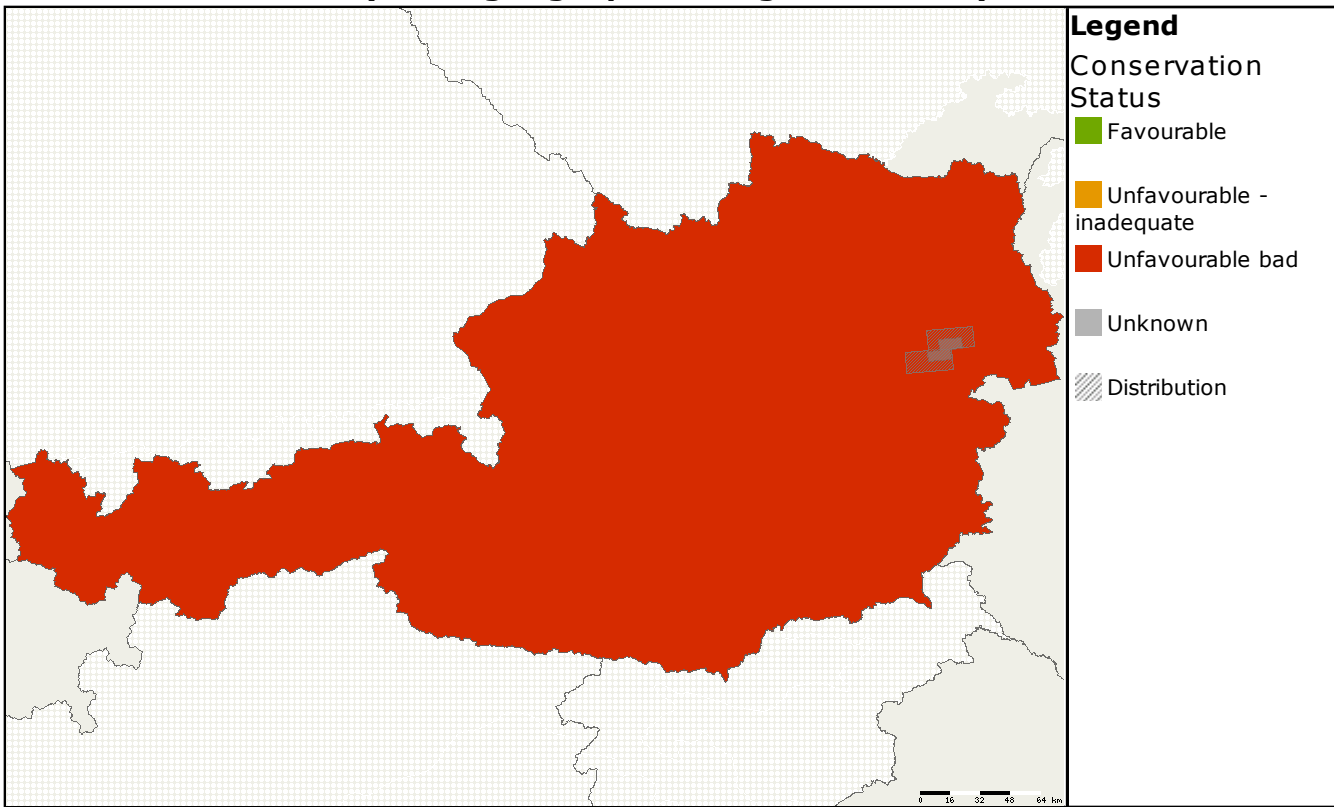

A subspecies of a primarily steppe gastropod mollusc. The subspecies is endemic to Austria. It occurs in steppe grasslands on calciferous sands or loess.

The conservation status in both the Continental and the Alpine biogeographical regions is 'unfavourable bad'. Recently it occurs only in few localities. The population size and the habitat area are decreasing. The species is threatened by destruction of habitat.
