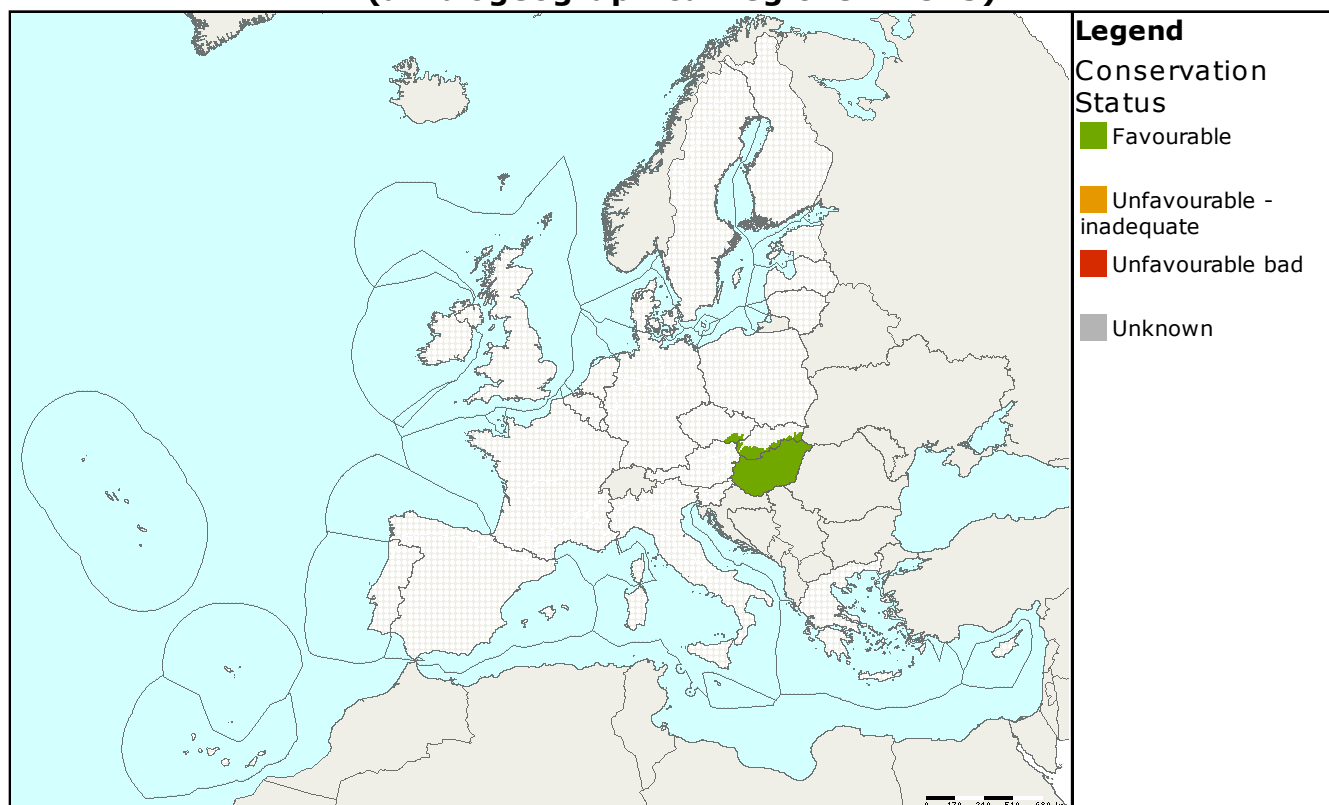

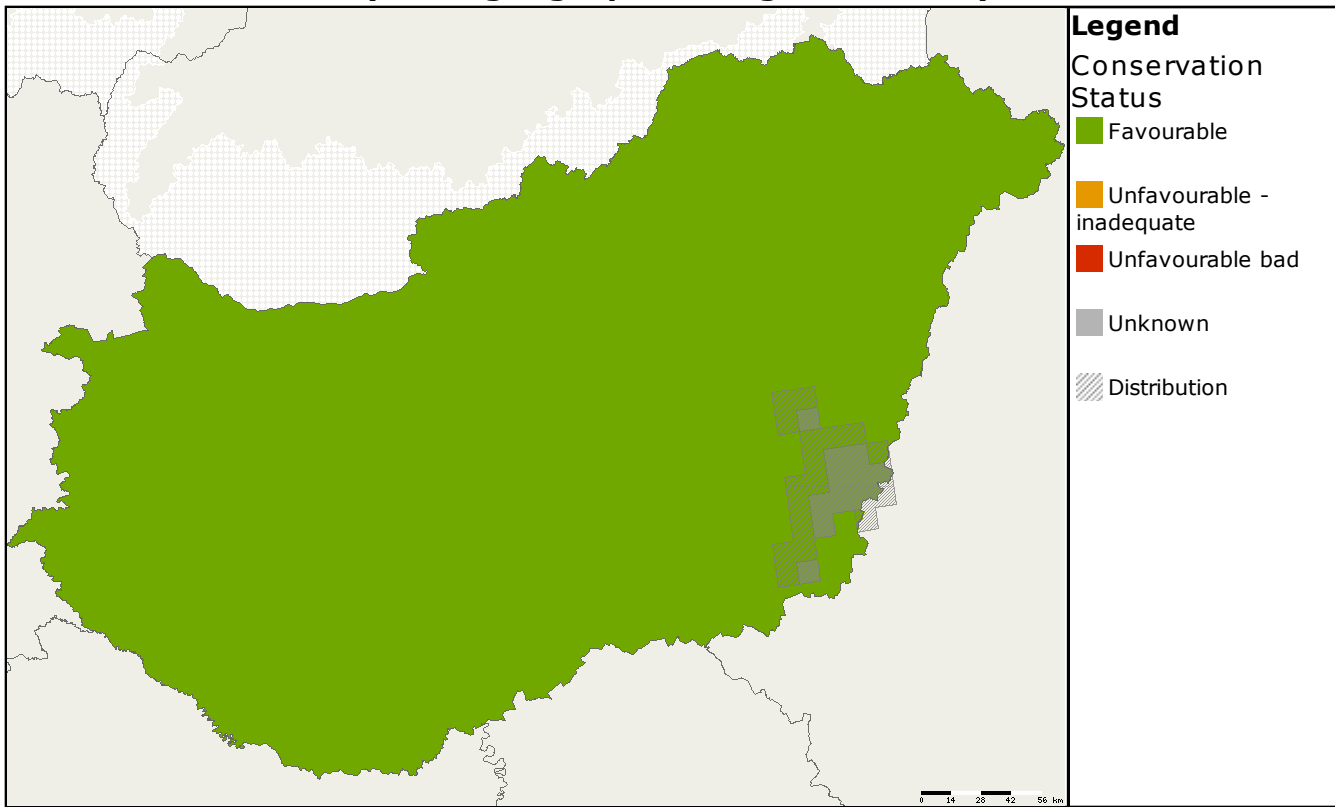

PAN: The species is local and endemic in the forests of Erdohat of Bekes county along the River Koros (HU). The distribution is uncertain in the adjacent parts of Romania. The centre of origin seems to be at the river head of the Koros river system. The species is a valuable endemic taxon living under special circumstances (the related species are distributed in mountainous areas). It has a very narrow range distributional. Although state of this species is assessed as "favourable" the habitat changes could become threats for known populations.
