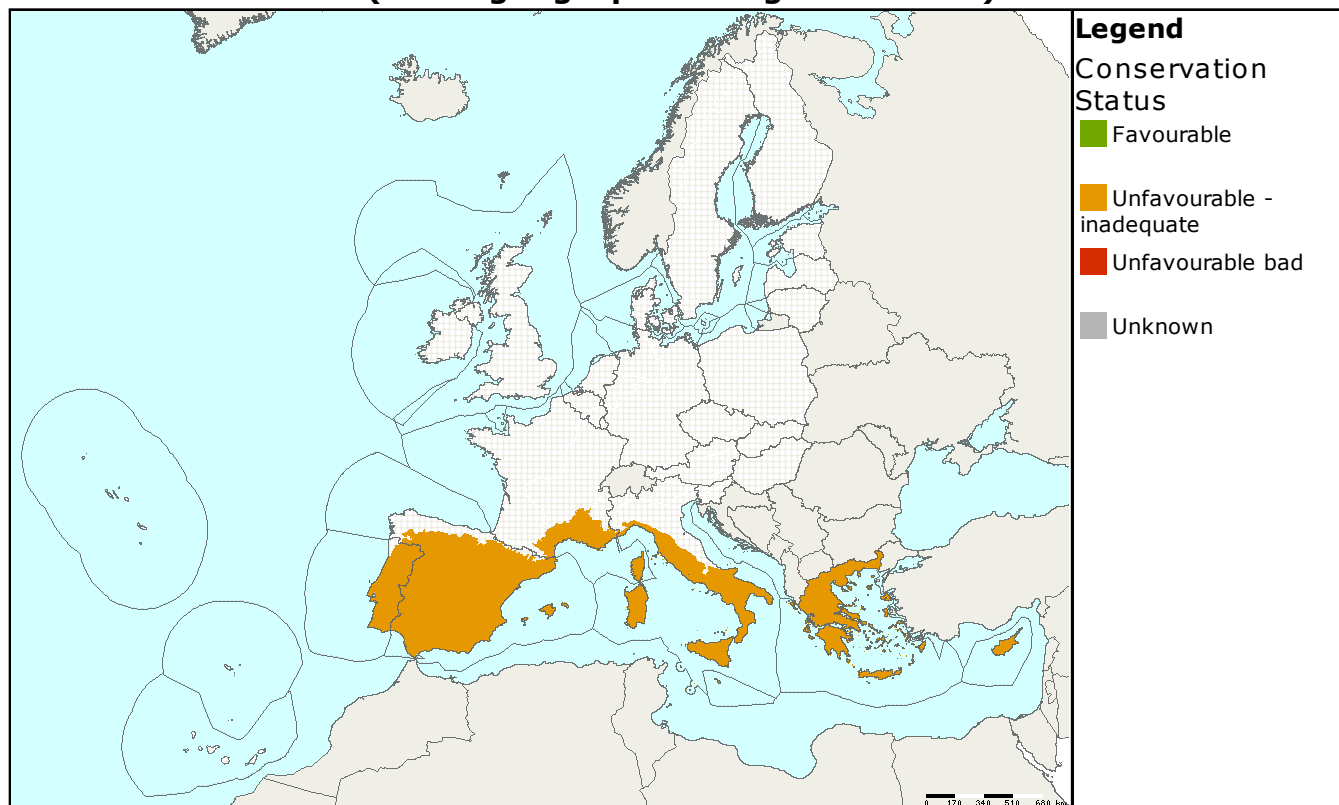

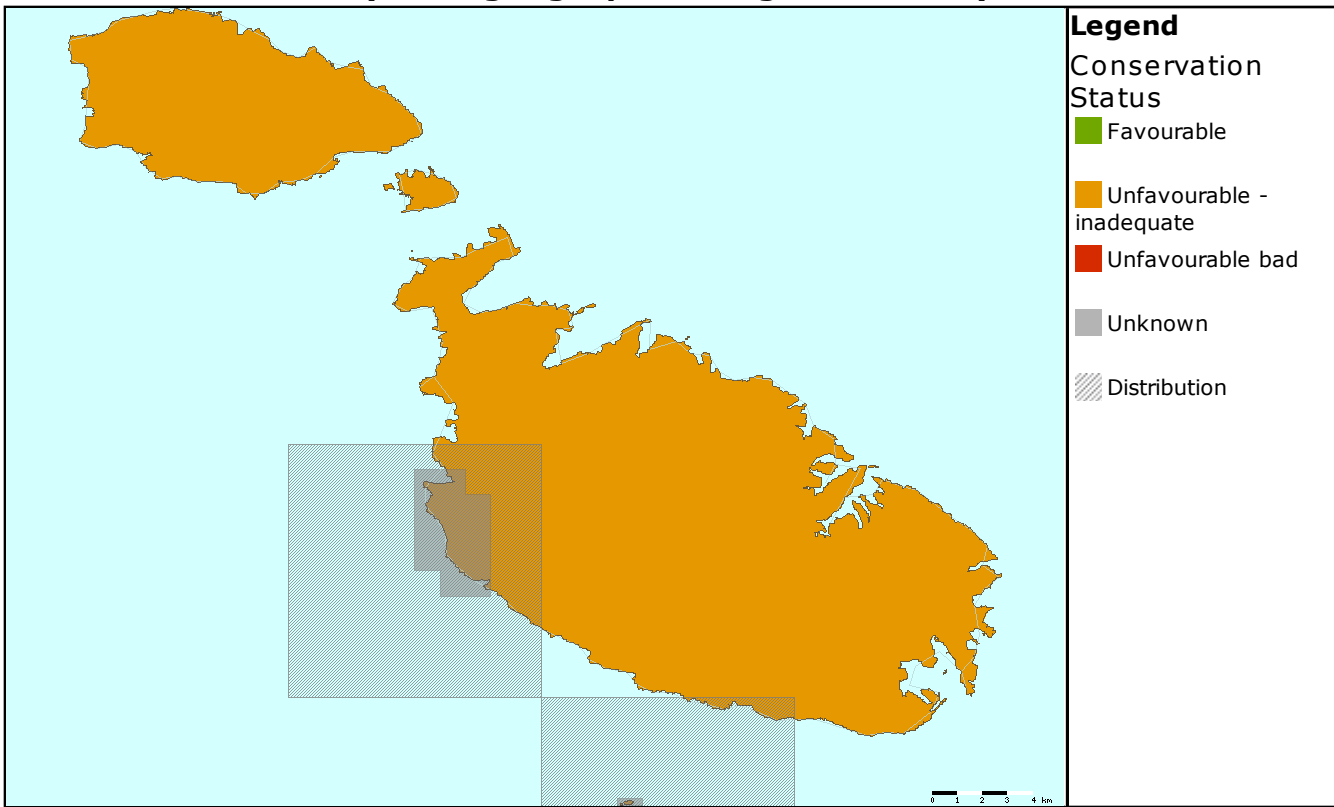

MED: *Lampedusa imitatrix* is endemic to the western region of the Maltese coastal cliffs in the Mtaħleb-Fomm ir-Rih area (as the type species) and the island of Filfla (as *L. imitatrix gattoi*). Its overall assessment is "inadequate" because species has been evaluated in 2 parameters as "inadequate" and other evaluated parameters have been marked as "favourable".
