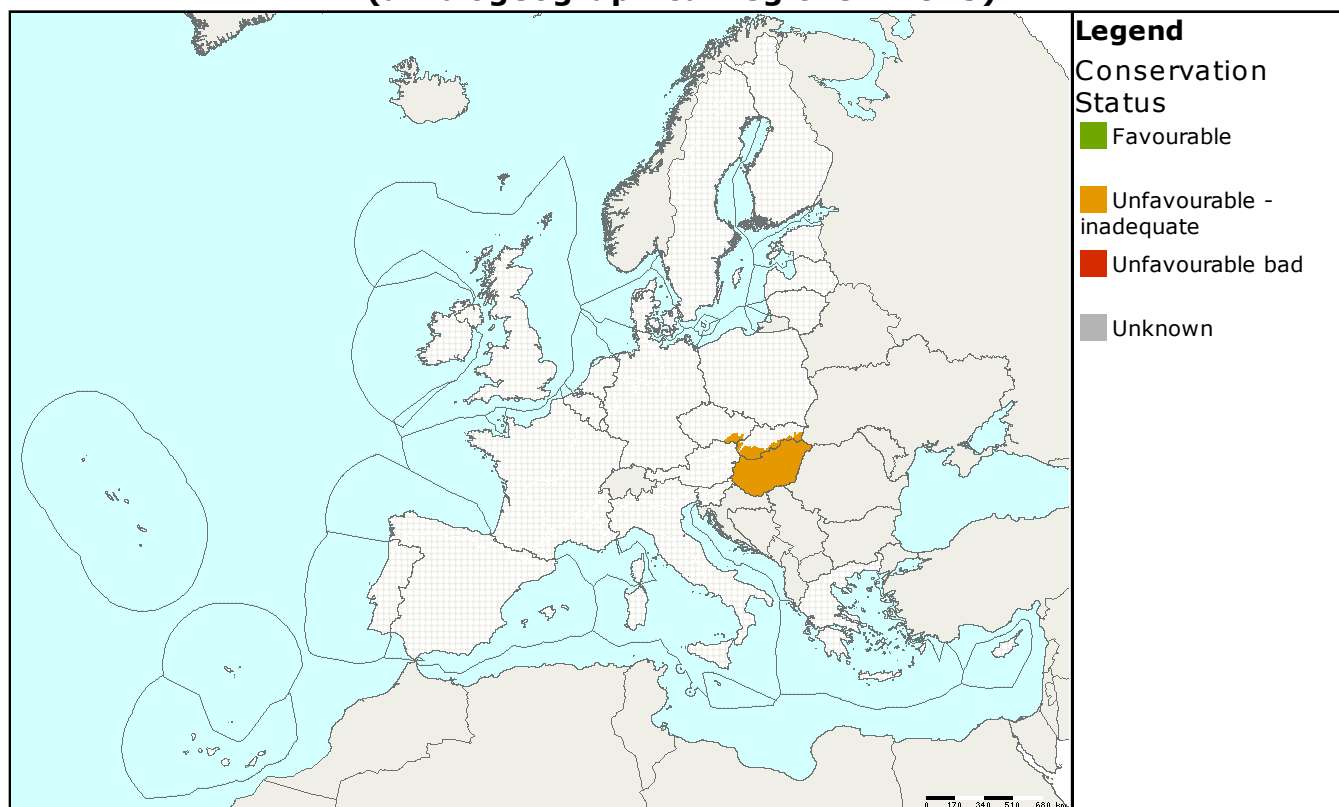

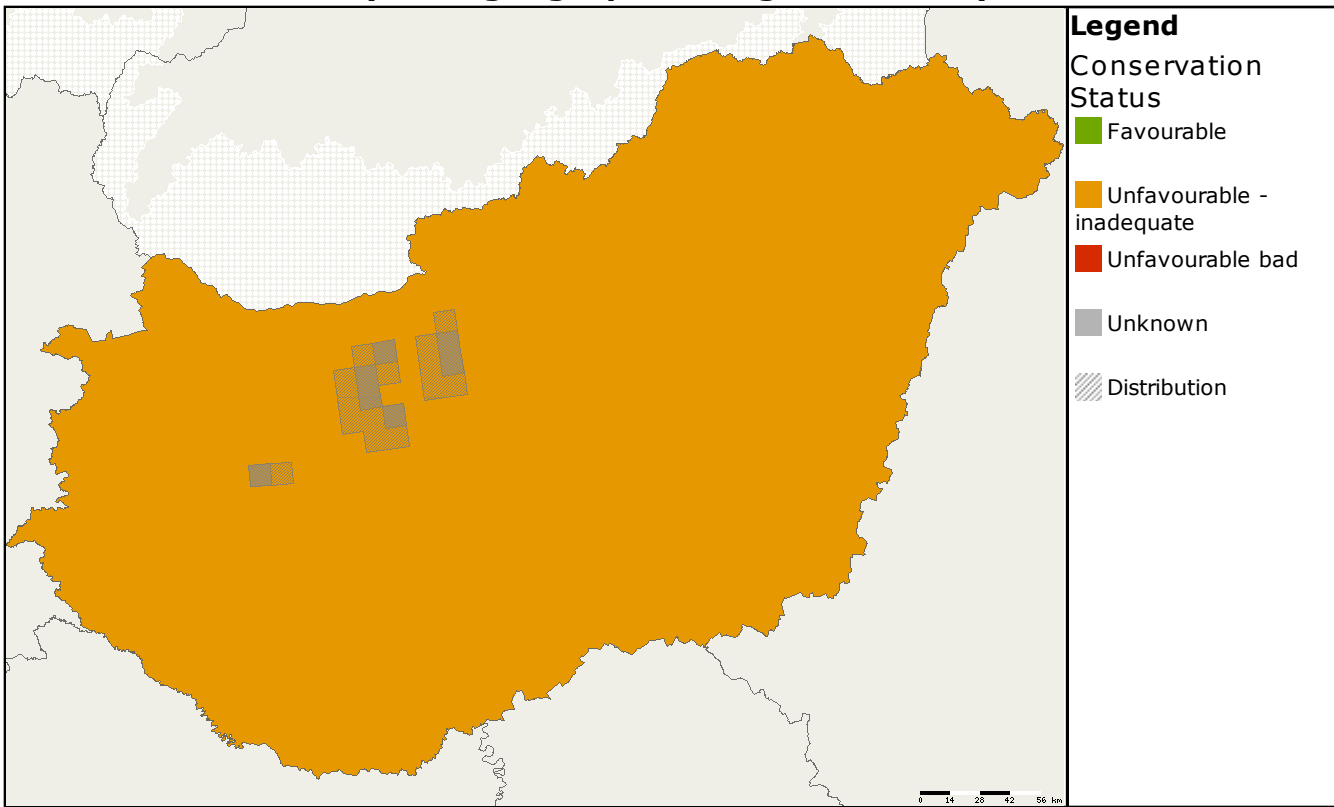

PAN: This species is recorded from the Pannonian biogeographical region only from Hungary. Its main habitats are closed or only slightly opened, rather tall rocky grasslands and steppes, on calcareous or dolomitic substrate, the species occurs also in saline flats in the western parts of its area. The larvae are polyphagous, the known foodplants are mostly different Compositae species, especially of Achillea. Its overall assessment is "inadequate" due to the "inadequate" status for habitat. In the Hungarian factsheet for the state of population actual value is the same as favourable reference and trend is stable, so conclusion for population should be "favourable" not "inadequate". This contradiction has no influence for the overall assessment of this species.
