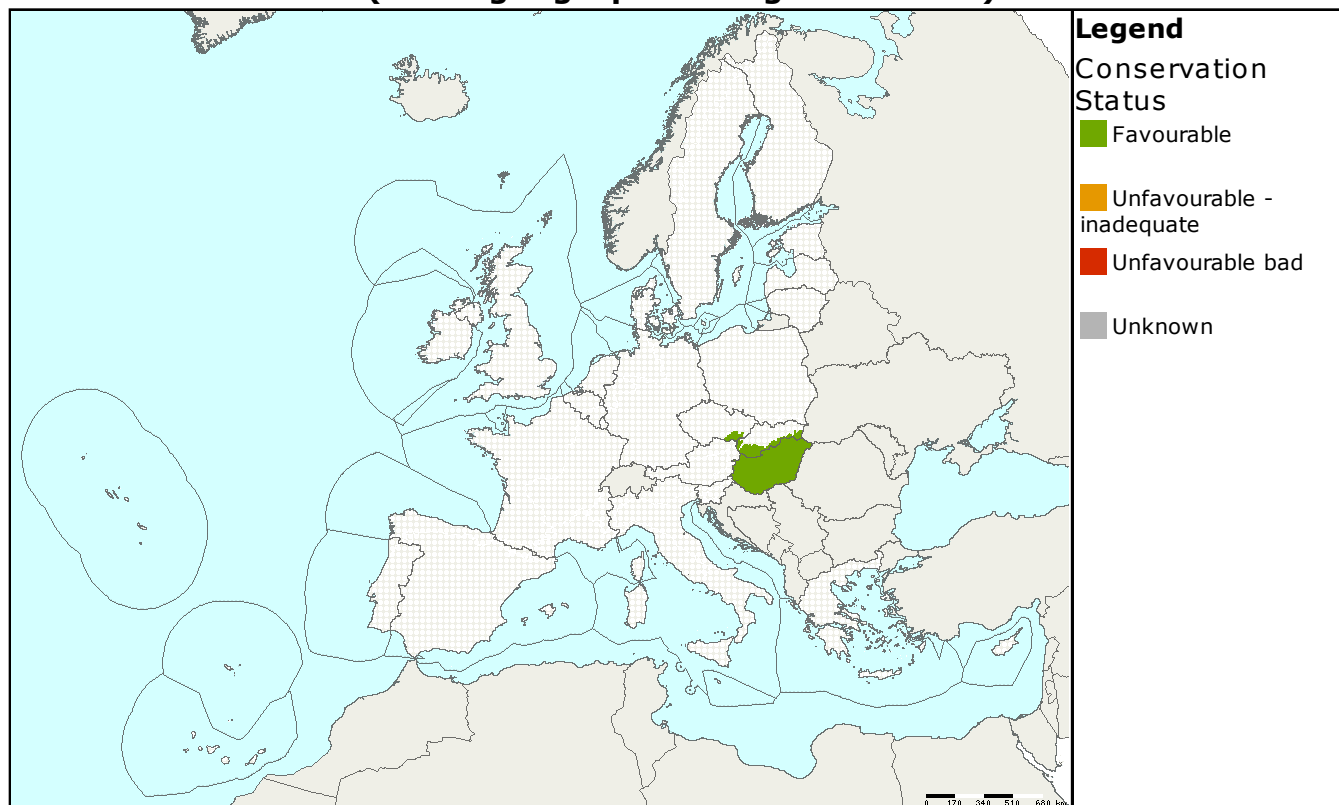

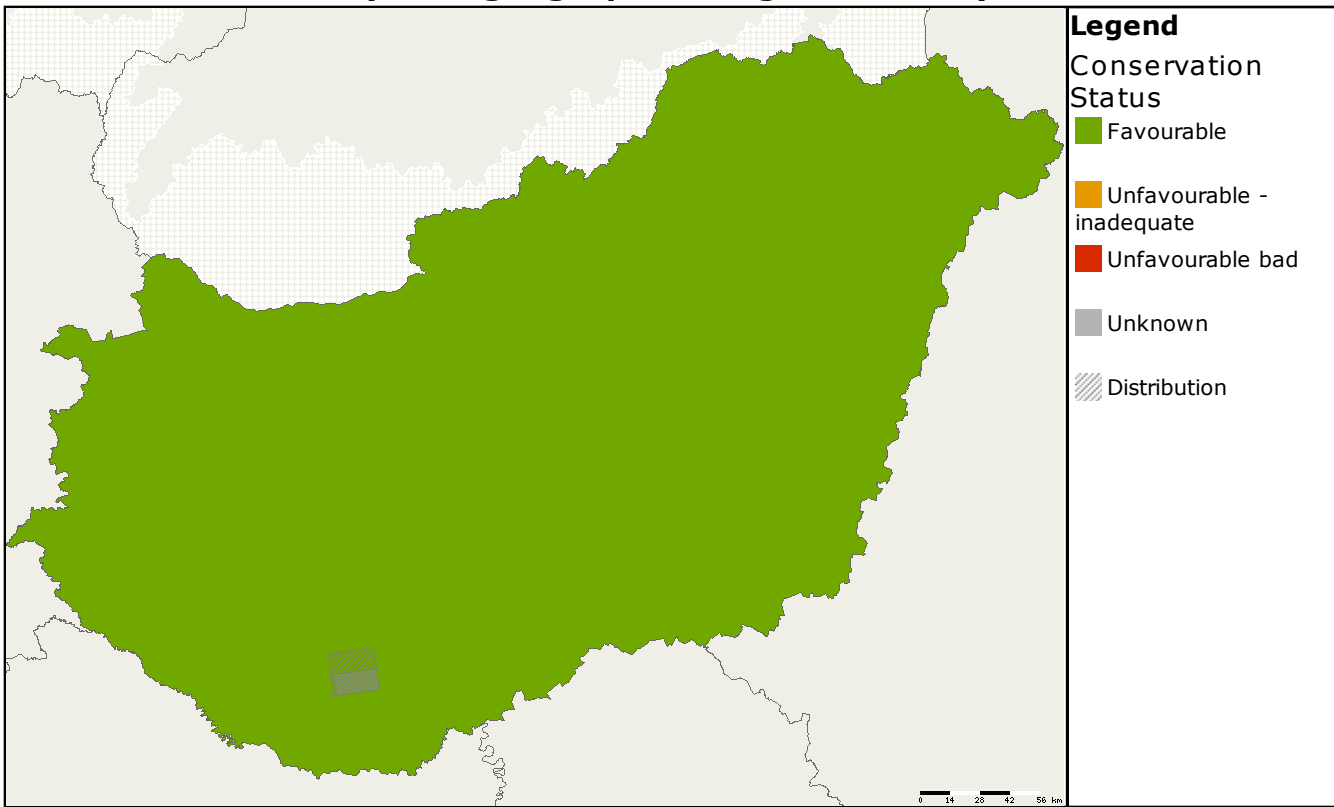

PAN: *Paladilhia hungarica* occurs in the undersurface waters of the Mecsek karst region. Live individuals have been reported from the brooklets of Mánfa-cave, but it is very rare. Larger populations inhabit undersurface waters of karstic region, since empty shells can be found in several springs. Although the species is marked as "favourable" it requires attention as endemic species occurring only in 1 locality.
