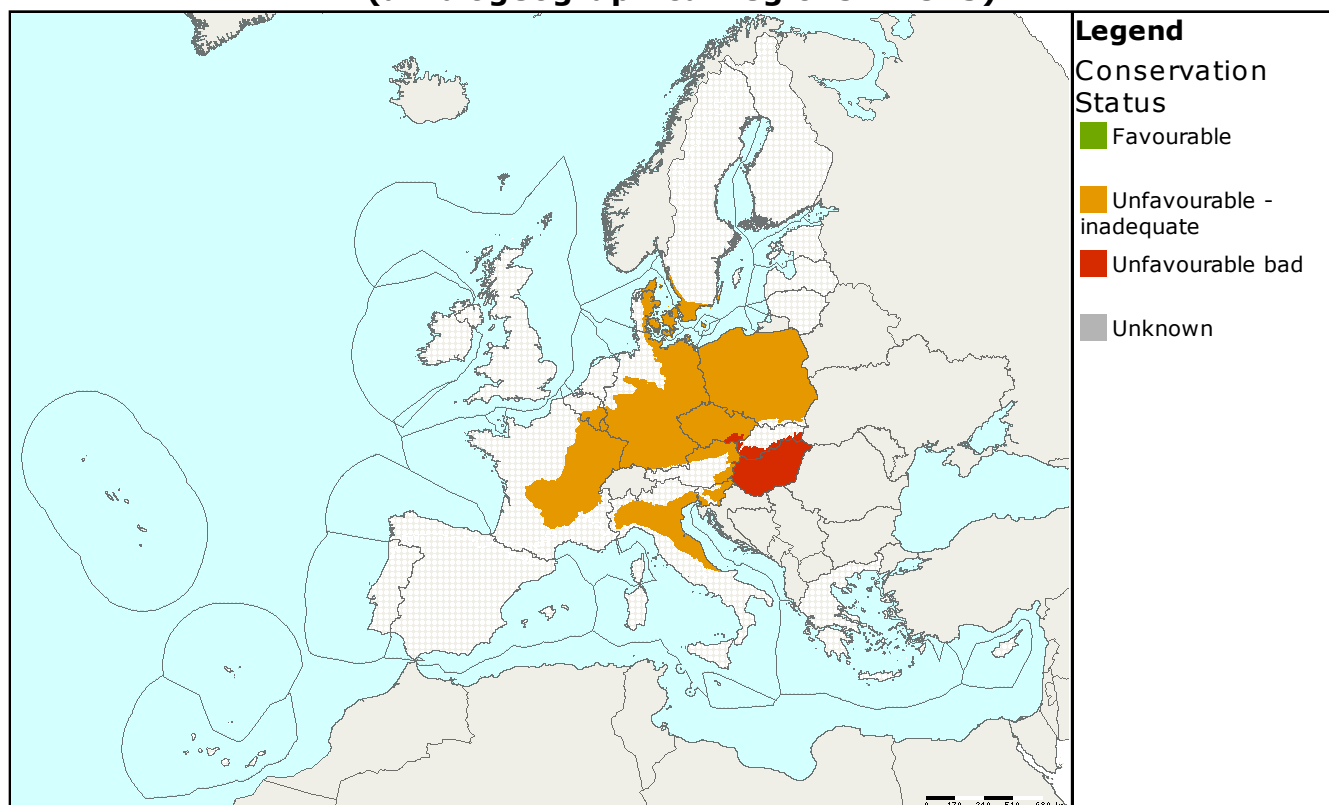

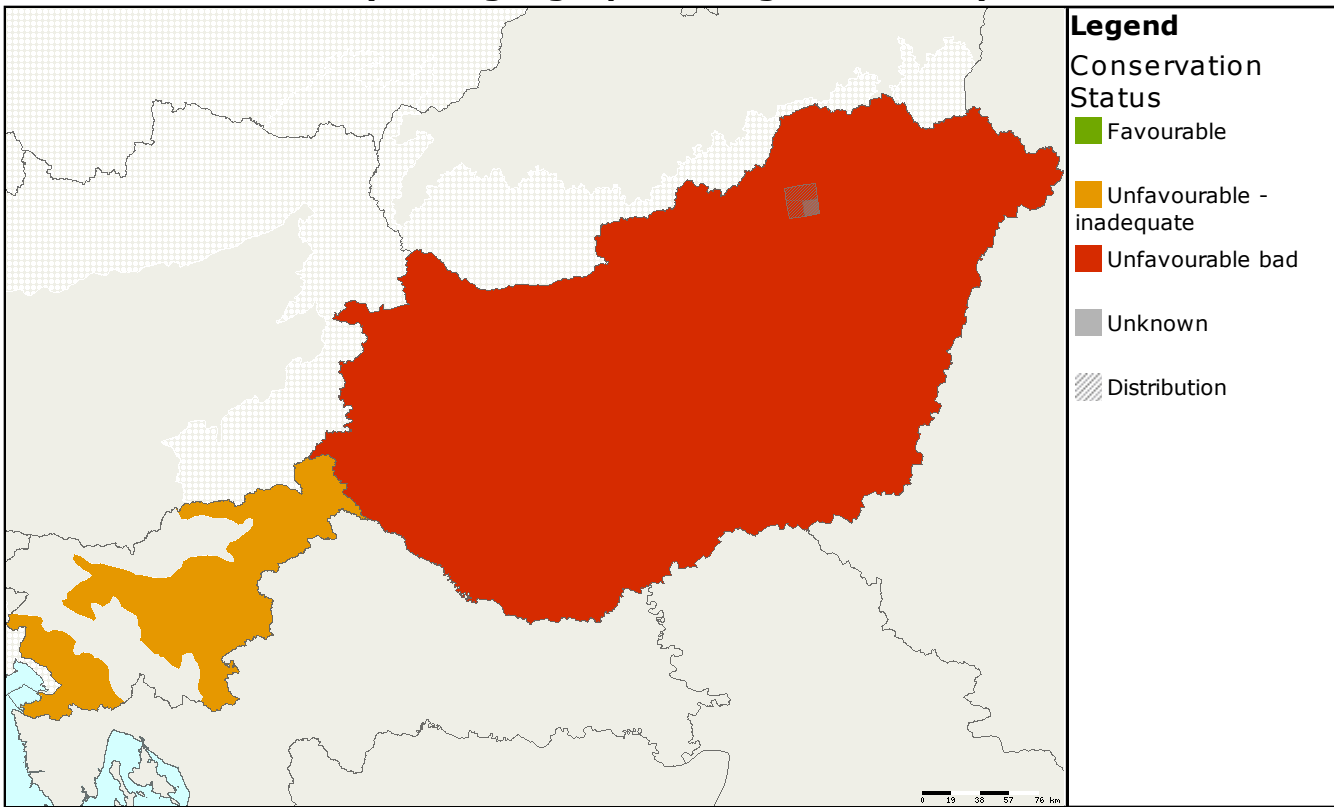

An aquatic gastropod mollusc occurring in thermal calcareous springs. It is a species of lowlands and its distribution is restricted to the Danube watershed. Within the EU it is known as well from Austria, Romania and Bulgaria.

The conservation status in the Continental biogeographical region is 'unfavourable inadequate', but this assessment does not concern the status of the species in Austria. As well the information provided by Slovenia has numerous gaps. In the Pannonian biogeographical region the status is 'unfavourable bad'. The distribution of the species is localised across the entire range. It is linked to the specific fragmentally distributed type of the habitat, which is sensitive to the environmental changes.
