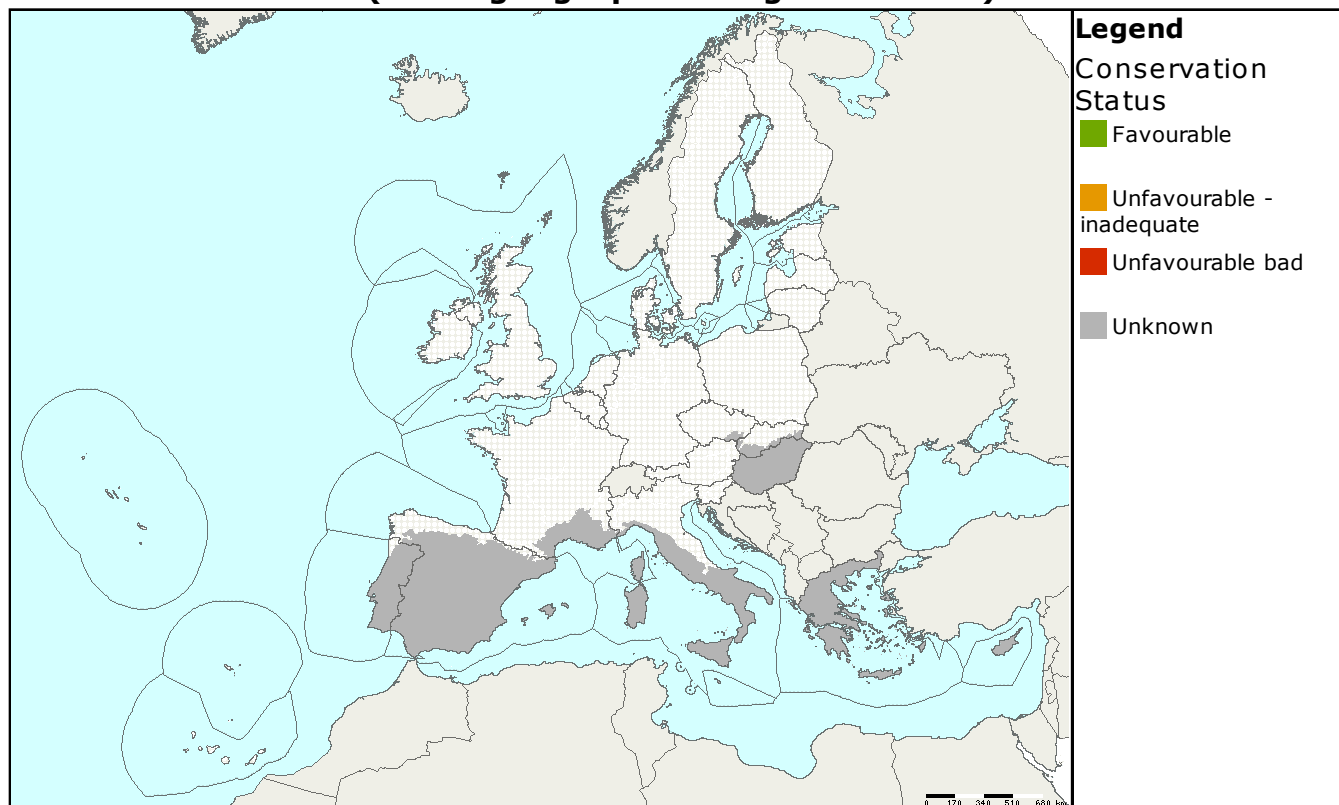

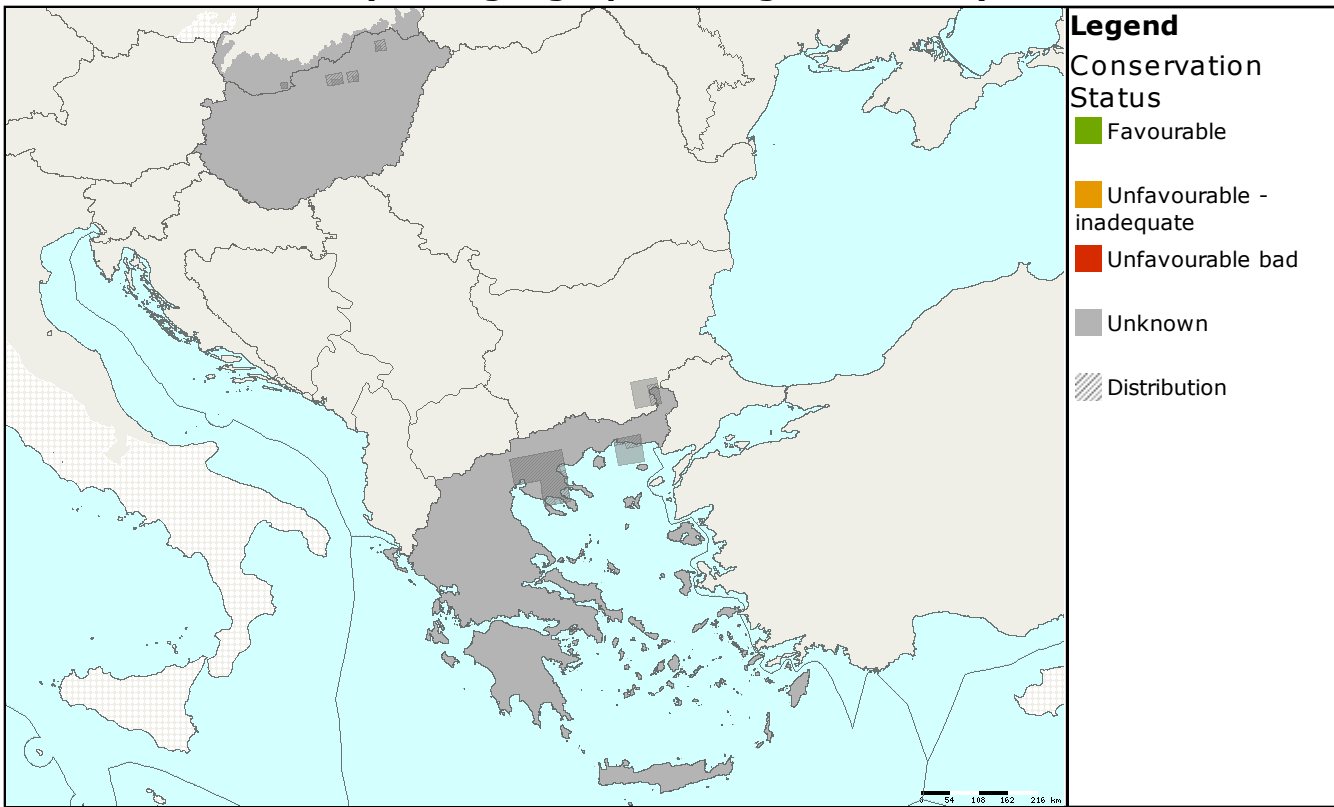

A species of beetle. In the Western Europe it is known from the Pannonian basin and from the Balkan Peninsula. Its natural range extends further to the east over the steppe regions of Ukraine and the southern Russia. It occurs in dry grasslands mostly on loess or other alkaline substrates.

The conservation status of this, in general poorly known species, in both the Mediterranean and the Pannonian biogeographical region is unknown. The data on the status and the trends are not available or are scarce. Mainly in the Pannonian biogeographical region the species occurs in small and isolated populations negatively affected by agricultural practices in the surrounding arable lands.
