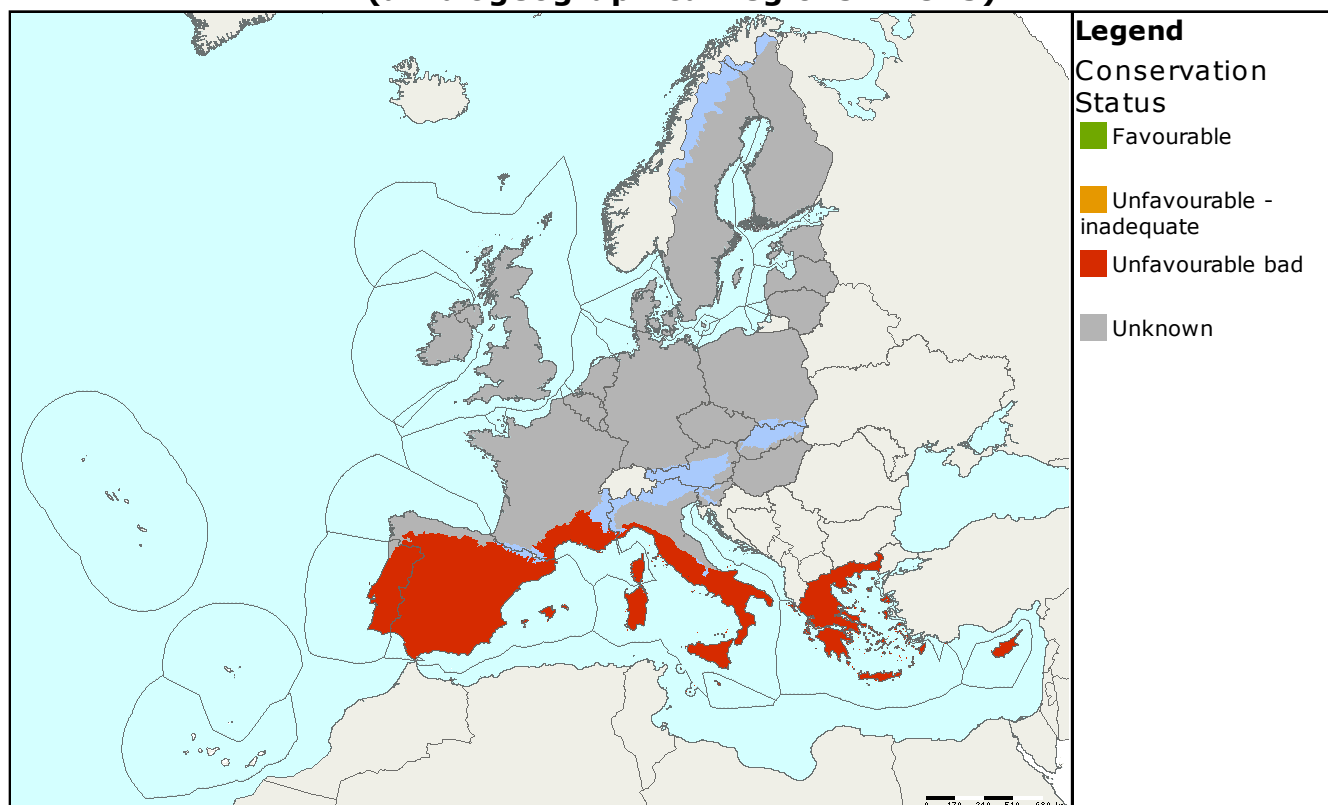

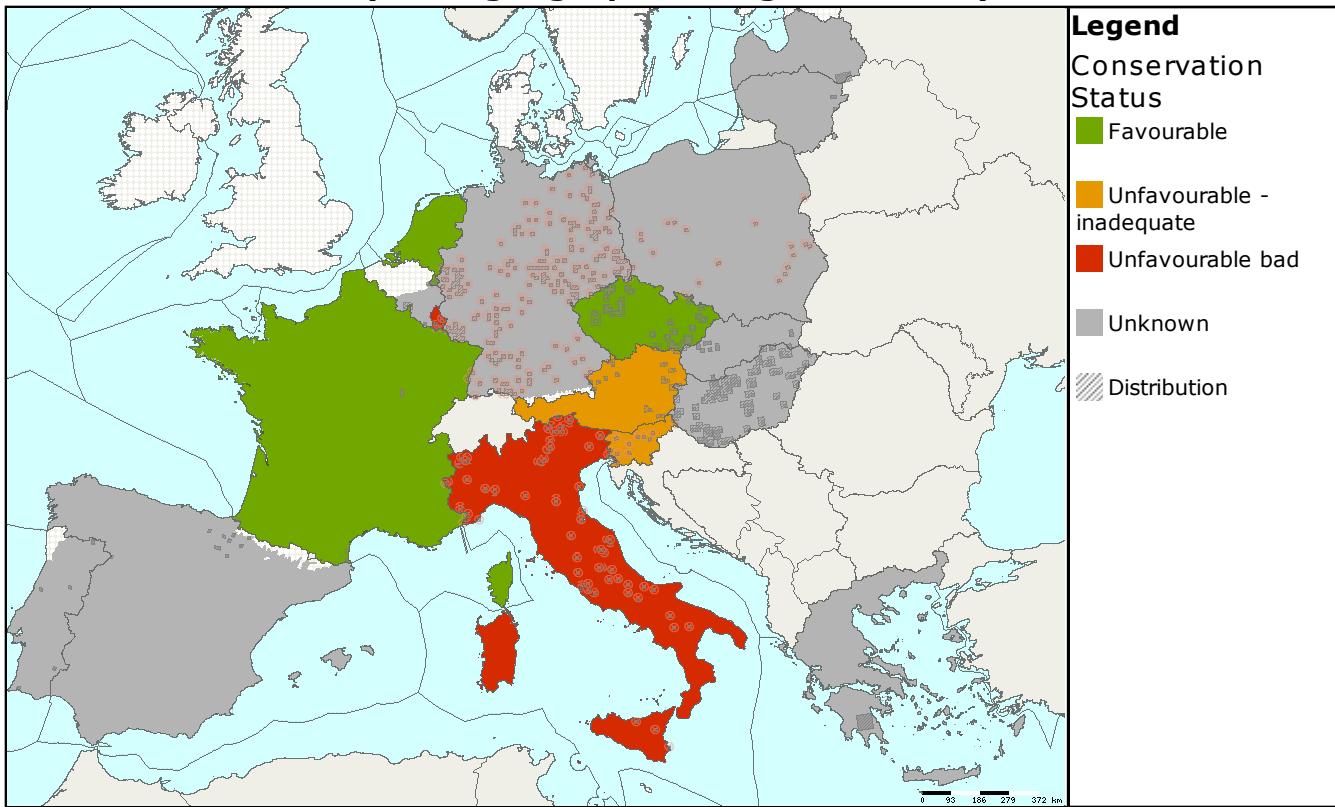

*Proserpinus proserpina* is a moth species widely distributed in Europe. Mainly found in damp, woodland clearings and edges of woods, especially in valleys. Country reports for this species vary from 'favourable' to 'unfavourable-bad'. However, there is a major lack of information about this species in all the regions and most countries reported the species as 'unknown'. Overall assessments are 'unknown' for Boreal, Continental, Atlantic and Pannonian regions. For Mediterranean region assessment is 'unfavourable-bad' mainly due to Italian report. According to IUCN species is 'data deficient'.
