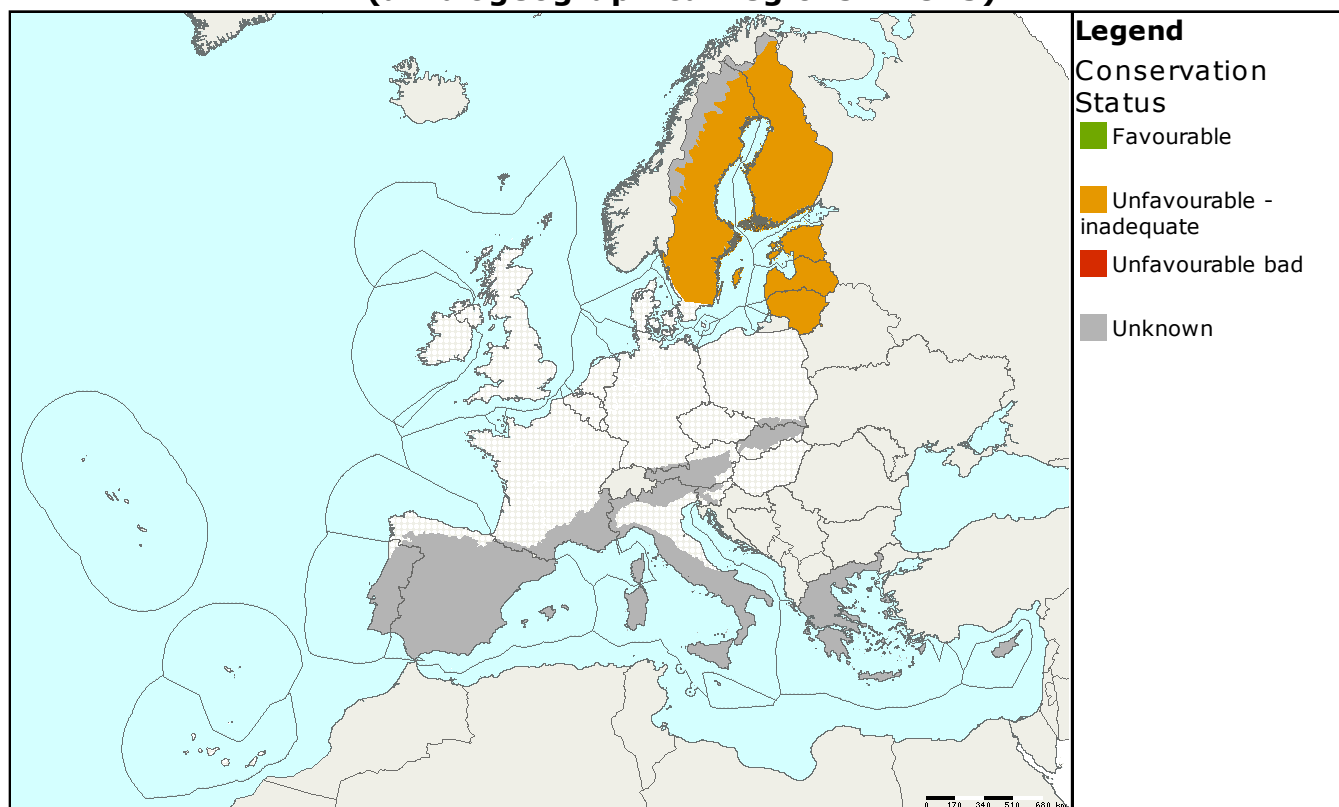

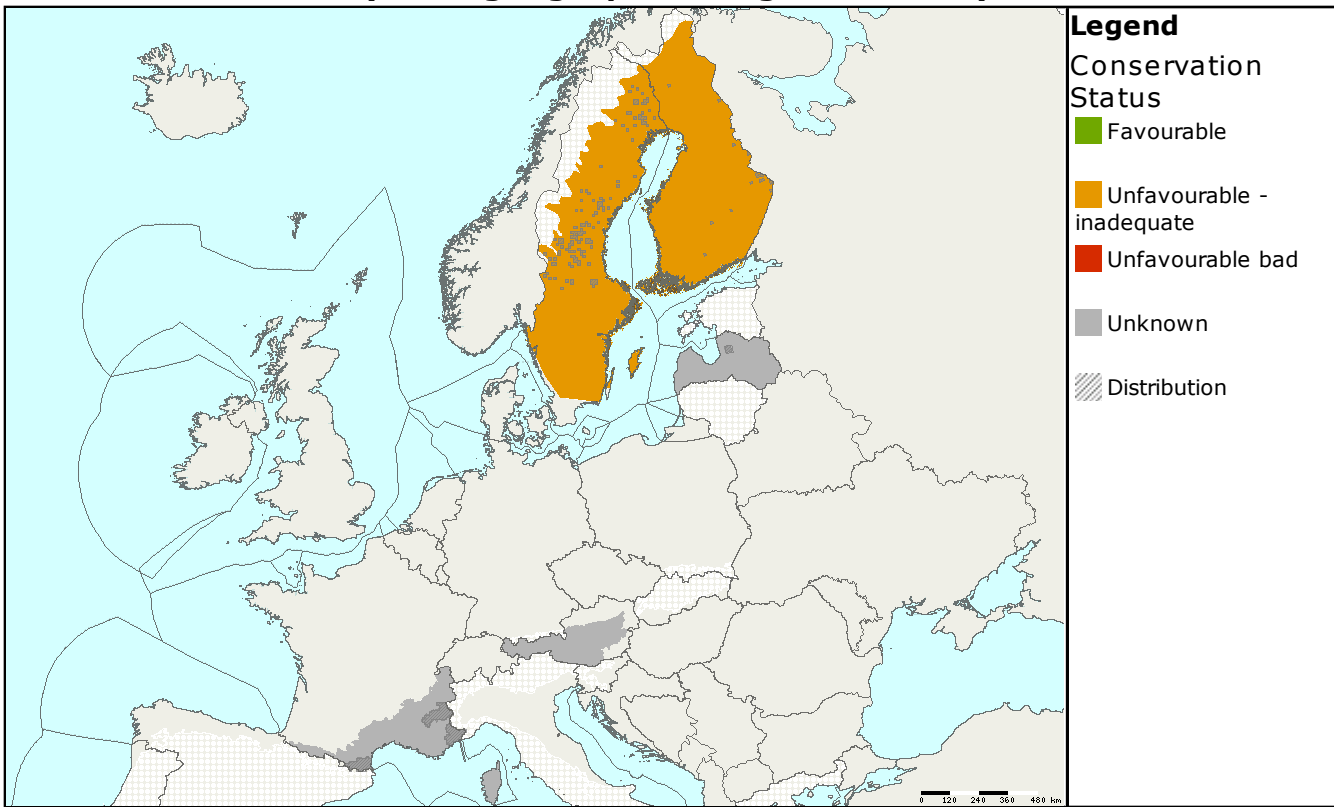

The *Stephanopachys linearis* is a beetle species which mainly inhabits parts of northern Europe.

In the Alpine and Mediterranean regions this species' status is assessed as 'unknown'. This is due to lacking data from France and Austria, which are the only countries from these regions where this species has been recorded as occurring. Data from Finland and Sweden lead to the overall assessment of 'inadequate' for the Boreal region. The range and population are 'favourable' for both countries and the habitat is currently 'inadequate but improving'. The most important country for this species is Latvia, but sufficient data from this country are lacking and only the habitat is assessed as 'favourable'.
