



The wild goat is currently present in three EU countries: Cyprus, Greece and Italy. However, Cyprus did not report on this species. Ourside of the EU it ranges discontinuously from central Afghanistan and southern Pakistan, west through Iran, western Turkmenistan, northern Iraq, the Caucasus region, as far as southwestern Turkey. It lives in several Greek islands and in the island of Montecristo in Italy. Its current range and population are smaller than in past times. It was assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' in both Greece and Italy where the main threats are linked to hybridisation with domestic goats, diseases and poaching. According to IUCN the species is considered as 'vulnerable'.
