



The grey seal is present in the marine Atlantic region along the coasts of the United Kingdom, Ireland, and on the European mainland coasts from Sweden to France (Brittany). Another geographically isolated population is present in the marine Baltic region.

The overall assessment in the marine Atlantic region is 'favourable' since more than 93% of the Atlantic population lies in the United Kingdom waters even though in the southeastern North Sea countries such as Belgium, Germany, the Netherlands and Denmark expressed an unfavourable-bad or inadequate conclusion for at least one of three parameters (population, habitat, or future prospects). In the marine Baltic region the status is 'unfavourable-bad' due the generally bad status of the species with the exception of Finland, Estonia and Latvia. The enclosed sea characteristic and the high pollution load of the Baltic sea play a significant role in the endangered status of this species. The species is listed, on a global level as 'least concern' in the IUCN Red List of threatened species.
