BOR: Overall assesment is unfavourable-bad due to the low population numbers and future prospects of this species whose land-locked characteristics isolate the species' presence only in Finland. The positive population trend was reported by Finland. However in last year of reporting period slight decline in population number was recorded, confirmed afterwards as well by 2008 census. In the opinion of Finnish Association for Nature Conservation the population trend may become negative in the future, what is connected with high mortality of young seals.


