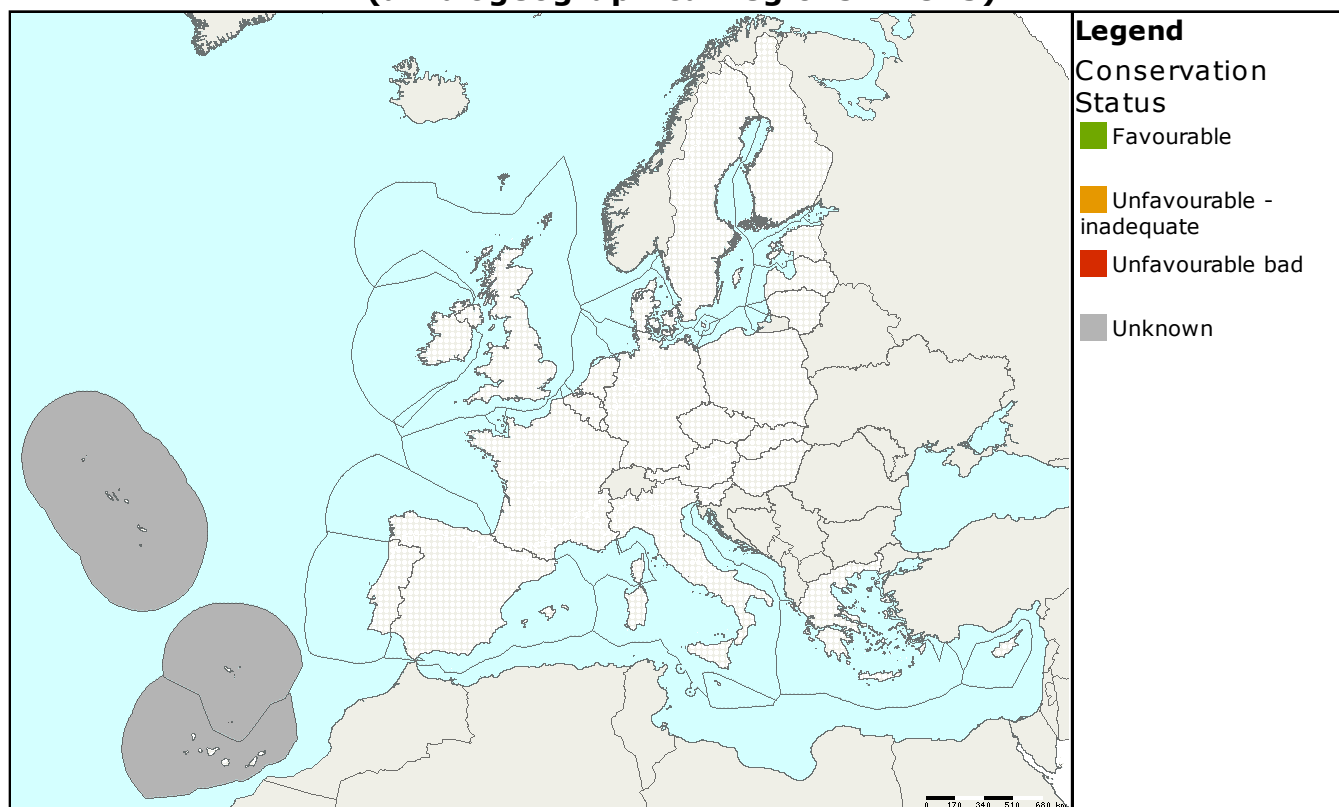

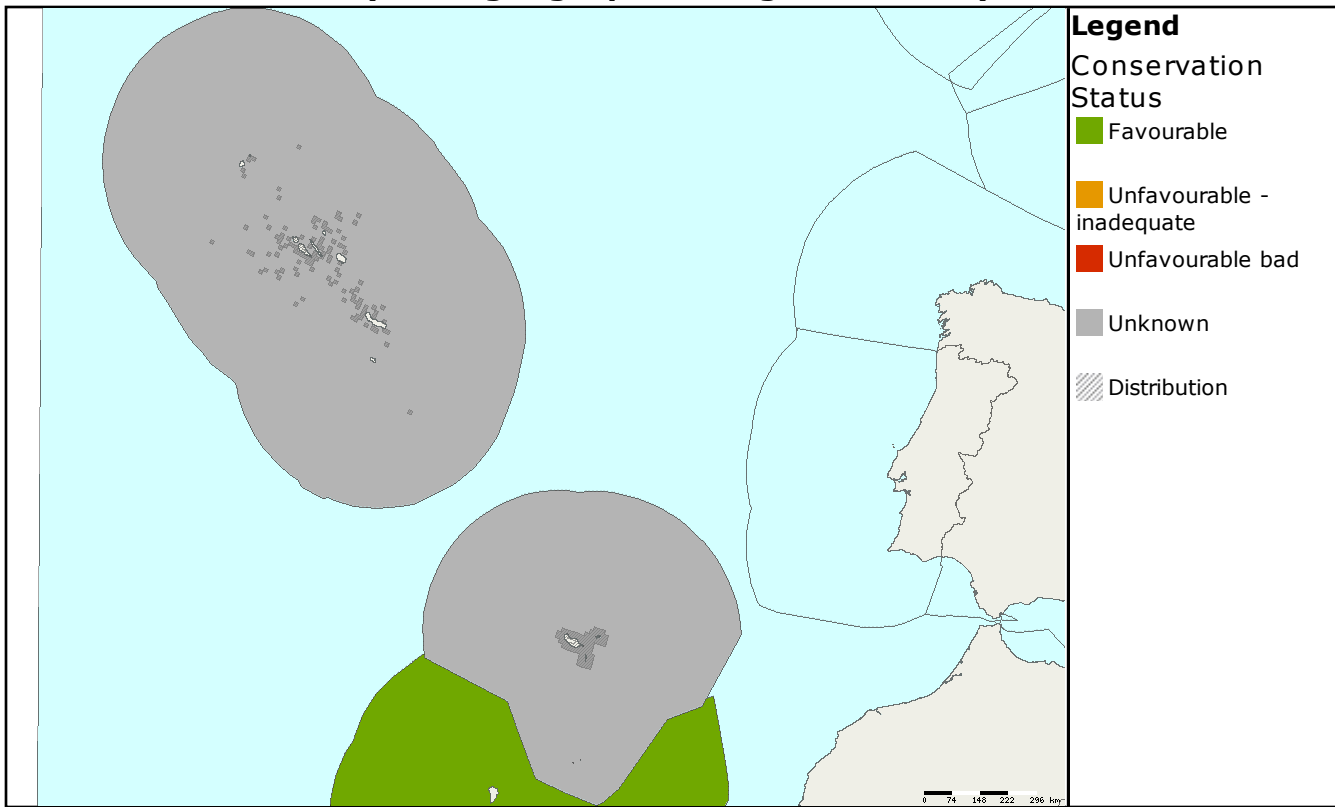

The short-finned pilot whale is distributed in the warm temperate waters of the marine Macaronesian region where it generally inhabits the deep offshore areas, ranging between 1000-2500 meters in depth, surrounding the islands of Madeira and the Canaries. The overall assessment is 'unknown' based on the Portuguese report for which range, population and habitat parameters are unknown. This conservation status is in line with its IUCN listing as 'data deficient' in the Red List of threatened species.
