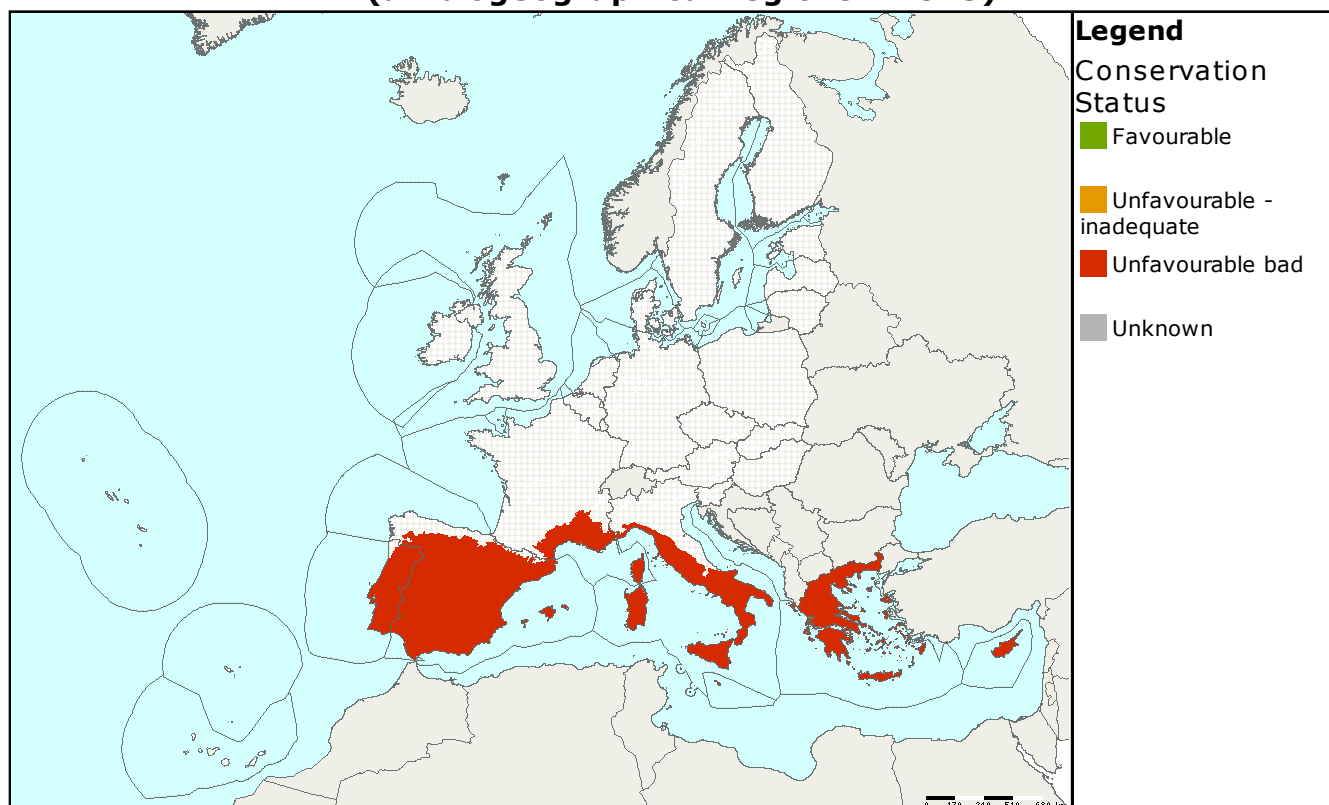

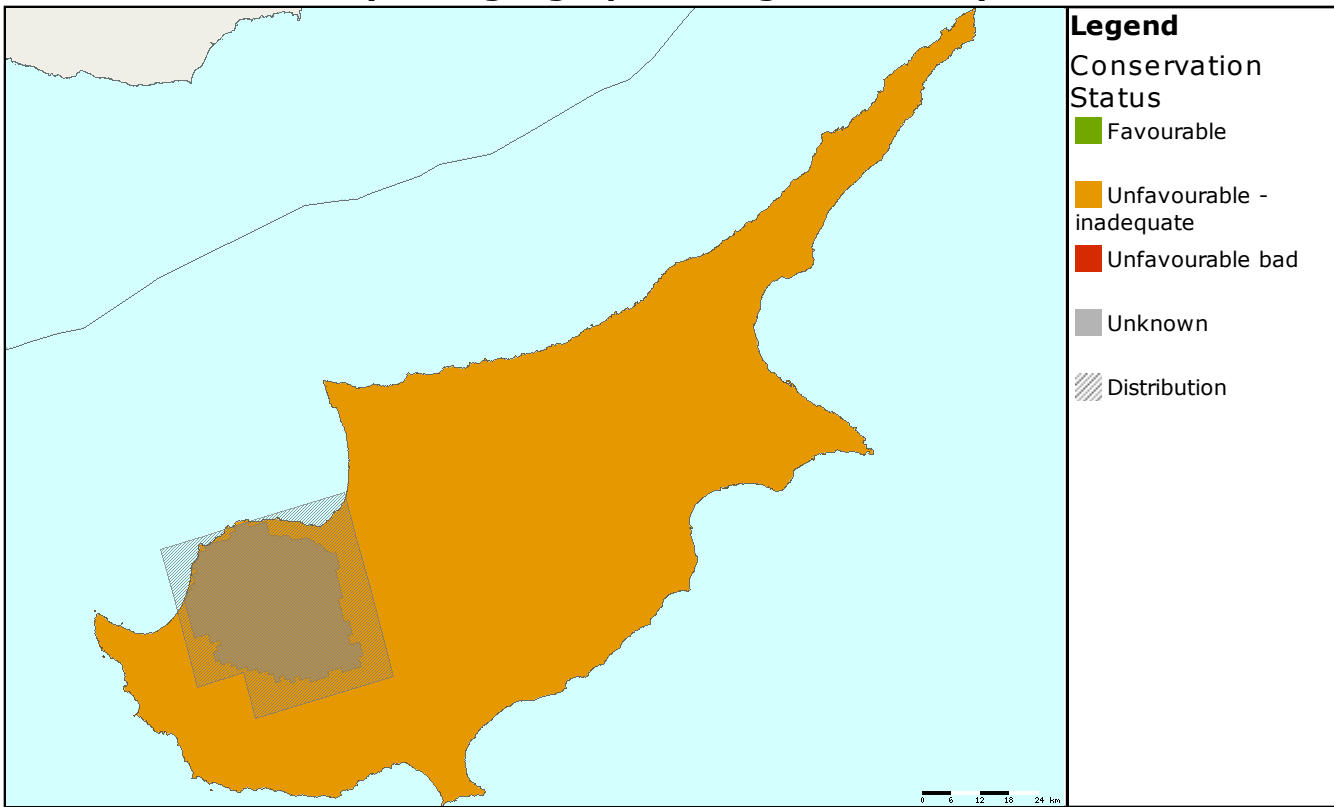

MED: The Cyprian Muflon has an 'unfavourable-bad' conservation status mainly due to the population size that is much lower than the 'favourable reference value'. According to the Game & Fauna Service and FEEO the species is actually threatened by lost and degradation of the habitat. The second mentioned unit propose 'unfavourable inadequate' assessment for this parameter. Both subjects support 'unfavourable bad' overall assessment.
