

The Blasius's horseshoe bat is reported only for Mediterranean region from Cyprus, Greece and Spain. It usually hunts in shrubland and woodland. Its summer and winter colonies are usually in underground sites. It is very poorly known and investigated all the assessments are 'unknown'. It is reported as 'least concern' in IUCN Red List.
