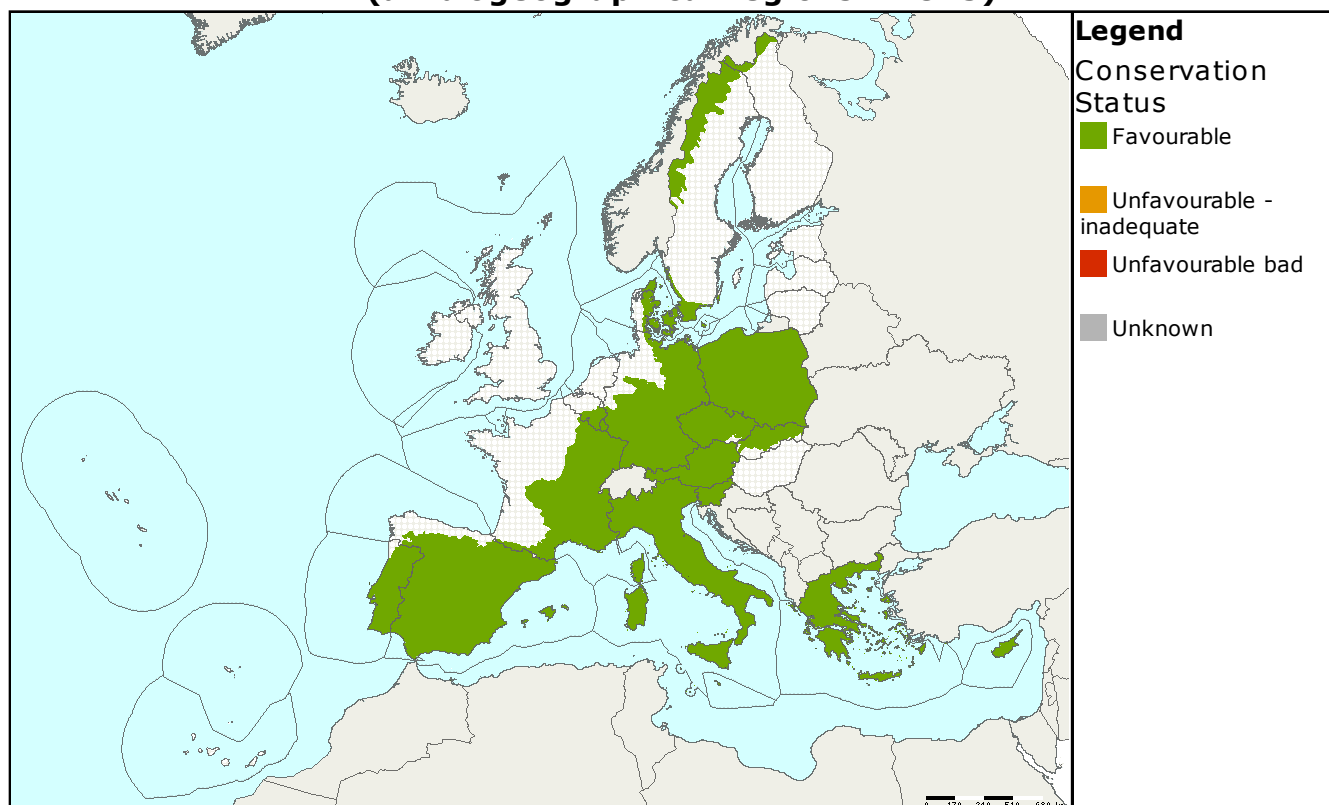

The *Adonis distorta* is a flowering plant species that is endemic to the Central Apennines of Italy.

The conservation status was assessed as ‘favourable’ for all the biogeographical regions (Alpine, Continental and Mediterranean). However, habitat data are all lacking and it is assessed as ‘unknown’.
