

Assessments of conservation status at the European level (all biogeographical regions - EU25)



The ancolie of Bertoloni is a long-lived herbaceous plant. It can be found mostly in the Alpine region. Abandonment of pastoral systems, forest planting, outdoor sports and leisure activities, as well as taking / removal of flora were reported as the major threats to the species.

It was reported by France, Italy and Slovenia. In the Alpine biogeographical region the 'favourable' overall assessment results from prevailing 'favourable' assessments at the Member State level. In the Continental biogeographical region the species was recorded in Italy at 3 localities. The assessment is 'unknown' due to a lack of information. In the Mediterranean biogeographical region the biogeographical assessment is affected mostly by the conservation status in France.
