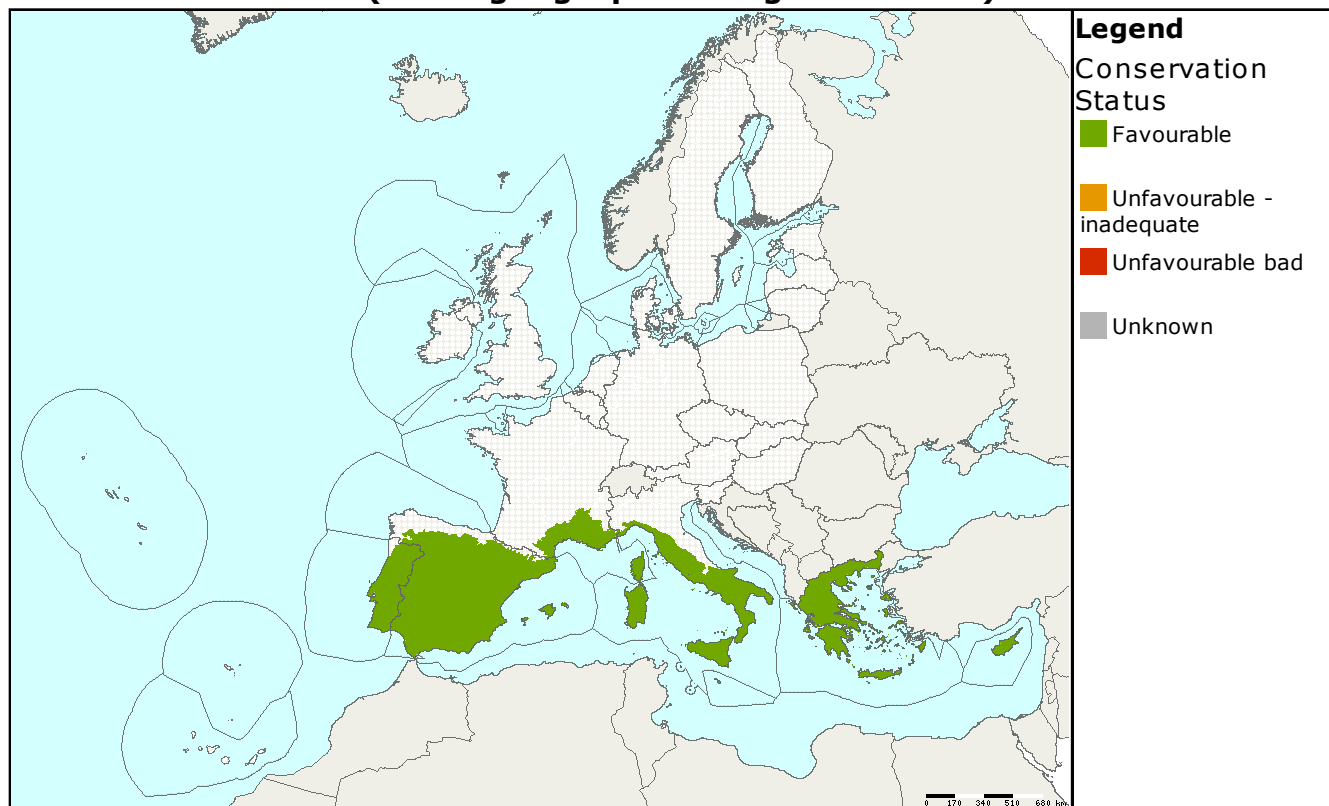

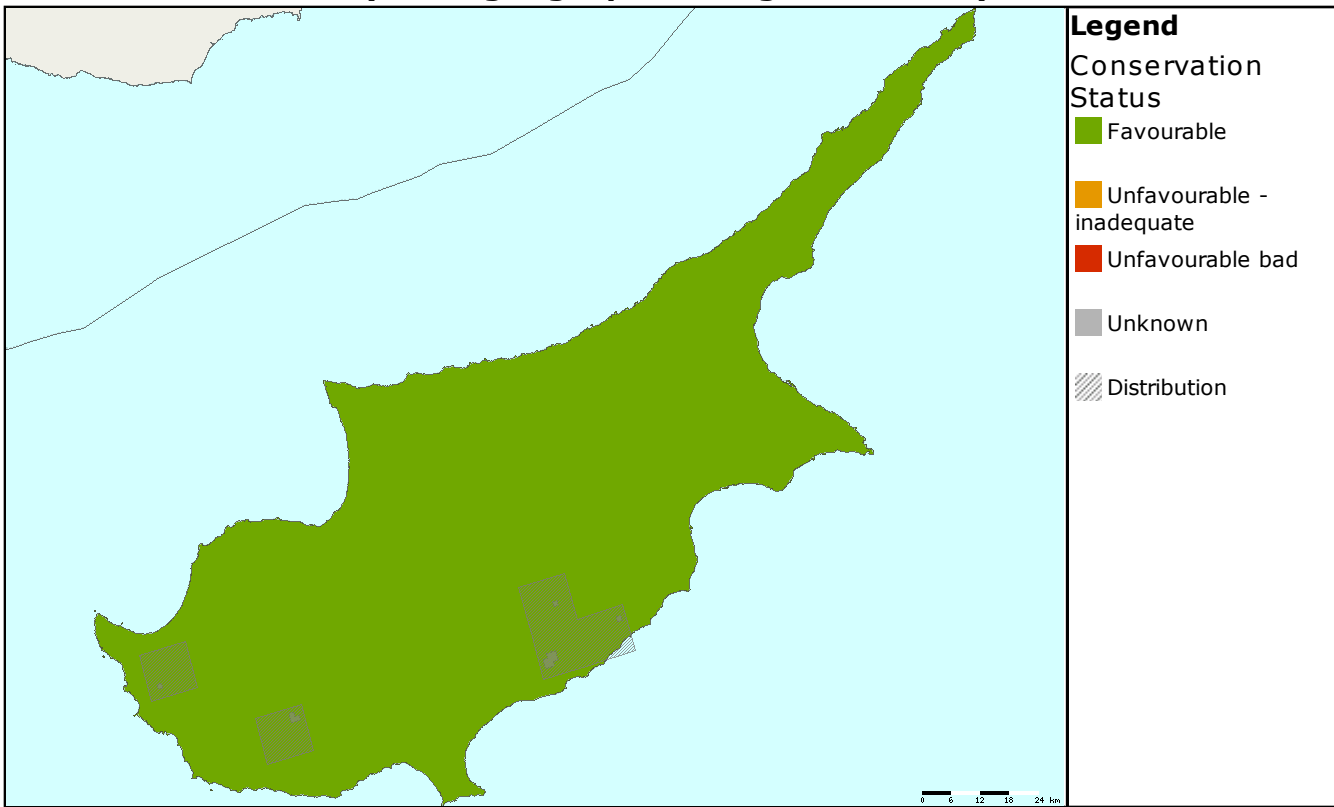

MED: Endemic to Cyprus which assessed all parameters as "favourable"?. Only 2 subpopulations are larger than the reported minimum viable population size while the Cypriot NGOs report a total population of 1874 individuals suggesting that the parameter population has not been correctly assessed.
