



Brassica insularis is an endemic Mediterranean plant which occurs only in Corsica, Sardinia and North Africa. It is reported by Italy and France in Sardinia and Corsica. France reported increasing trend for this species. All parameters were assessed as 'favourable' except the habitat parameter in Italy ('unknown'). Overall assessment is 'favourable'.
