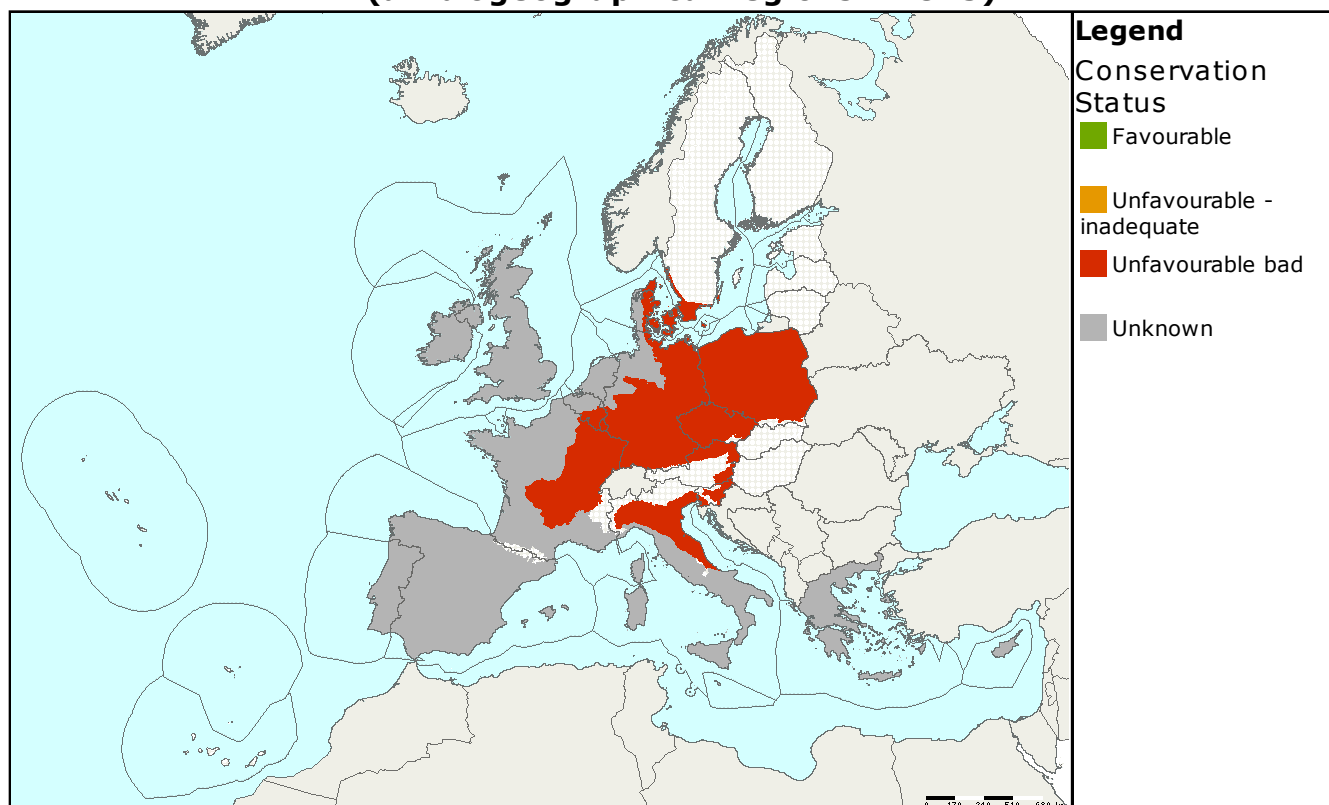

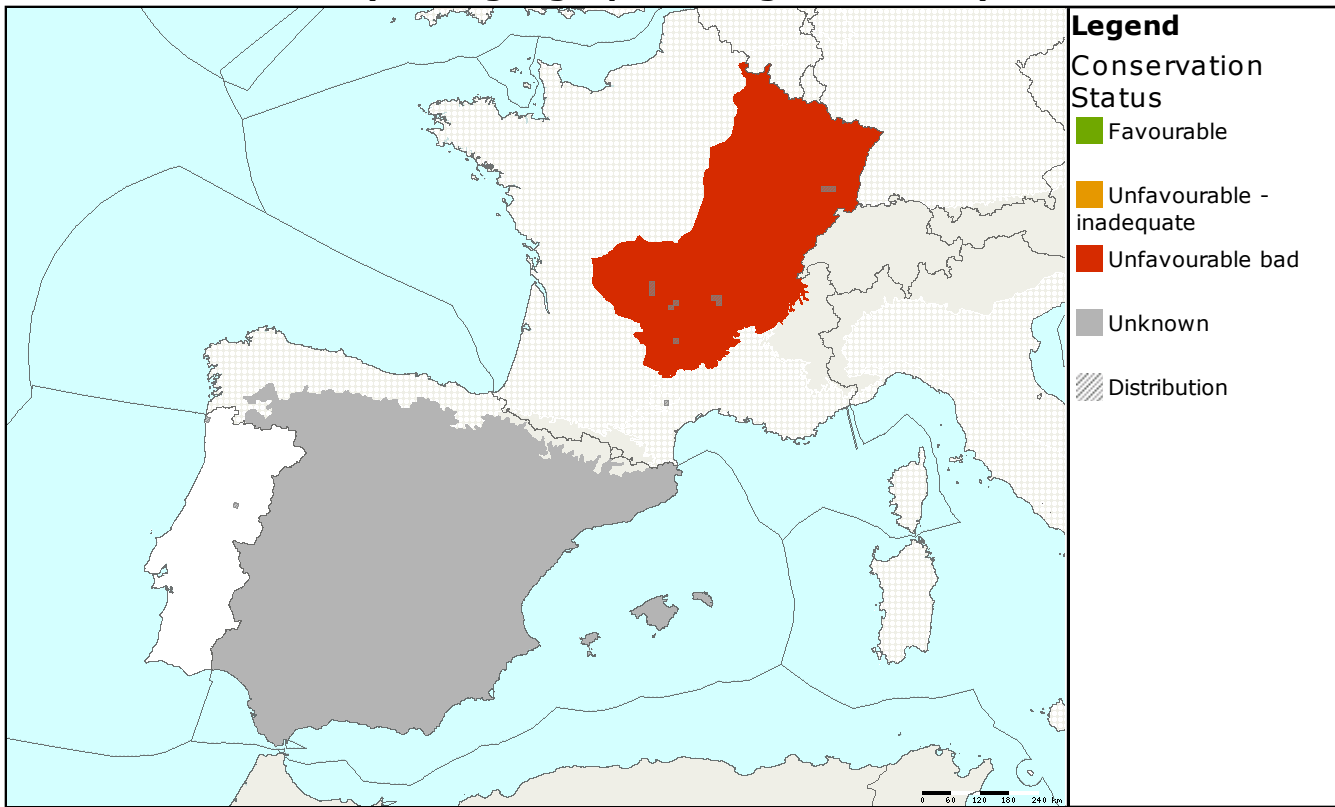

The *Bruchia vogesiaca* is a plant species which occurs in the hills of the Vosges and the Central Massif.

Due to the lack of data from Portugal and Spain the status of the Atlantic and Mediterranean region is assessed as ‘unknown’. In France, the only country of the Continental region, this plant’s status has been assessed as ‘bad’. Future prospects are bad due to land use changes.
