



The Macoun's cephalozia is a liverwort strictly confined to densely shaded spruce-fir forest, on large, moist, shaded logs. It is sparsely distributed in Boreal biogeographical region of Finland and Sweden. Outside Europe it occurs in Siberia, China and North America. It is assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' for Boreal region due to the range in Sweden being much less than the Reference value.
