



Crepis pusilla is rare and poorly known plant species reported in Mediterranean region by Cyprus, Greece and Malta. It is also known from Mallorca (Spain) and Portugal but not reported. Overall assessment is 'unknown' but reported as 'unfavourable-bad' by Malta and it is clearly not favourable for the region. Better information required in the future.
