

Iris lusitanica is a flowering plant reported from the central part of the western Portugal and western Spain as a Lusitanian endemic species (Mediterranean region). Almost no data reported from Spain and very scarce data from Portugal (e.g. poor future prospects) do not allow different overall conclusion than 'unknown'.
