



A plant species endemic to the Spanish Pyrenees. It occurs in xerophilous communities of limestone cliffs.

The conservation status in both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean biogeographical region is 'unknown'. However the natural range of the species is restricted, many sites have been lost due to collecting. The reports for this in general poorly known species provided by Spain are incomplete. Better information is required to allow assessment of conservation status.
