



The hoop petticoat daffodil (Narcissus bulbocodium) is a plant species occurring in Spain, Franca and Portugal.

For the Alpine region it is reported from the Pyrenees. Spain hosts almost 70% of the population. Overall conclusion is 'unfavourable-bad' due to French habitat and future prospects regarding 30% of the entire population in this region (even though in Spain these parameters are 'favourable'). In Atlantic and Mediterranean regions overall conclusions are 'unknown' due to Spanish situation.
