



An Annex IV plant species. N. triandrus calax, a subspecies of N. triandrus endemic to north-western France is listed in Annex 2. It is evaluated separately. N. triandrus occurs apart of France in north-western part of Iberian Peninsula. It was reported by both Spain and Portugal. This species occurs in various types of natural and semi-natural habitats, like grasslands, forests, forest fringes and shrubs.

The reports for this in general poorly known species are incomplete. Conservation status was not assessed at the national level in Portugal although the range and the habitat area are decreasing. The completeness of the data does not allow for other than the 'unknown' conclusion for both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean biogeographical regions.
