



Petalophyllum ralfsii is a liverwort growing mostly in calcareous dune slacks in sand dunes. Its status of conservation is "impossible to be assessed" for the Mediterranean region. For the Atlantic region the overall assessment is "unfavourable-inadequate", despite many individual parameters are reported as "favourable". All parameters reported by Spain are "unknown".
