



A plant species endemic to a small area in western Bierzo in north-western Spain. It occurs on dolomite and calcareous cliffs and outcrops of rock.

The conservation status in both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean biogeographical regions is 'unknown'. The species geographical distribution is limited and it persists in small isolated population, which represents a major threat. The reports for this in general poorly known species provided by Spain are incomplete. Better information is required to allow assessment of conservation status.
